# **January Devotion**

Is there the need to better control your anger? Have you thought about improving your level of patience? Have you reflected upon deepening your level of forgiveness toward those who have wronged you? Have you considered how your ways of responding to people and situations in life may better mirror for others the ways of Jesus?

Have you evaluated your spiritual health recently? How often do you find yourself being aware of God's presence? How attentive are you to obeying the urging of God's Holy Spirit to do, or not to do, something? What do you expect God to do for you? What are you willing to do for God?

I find I have the tendency to believe that I have arrived and have become the person God intended me to become. Being honest, I have to acknowledge that I have a long way to go in changing my inner being to become what God has given me the capacity to become.

God's calling to us is for us to daily be striving to improve and refine the quality of our lives, for our good, and for God's good to be done through us. May 2024 be a year in which you and I both realize improvements that we have made in our inner selves, which we make in thanksgiving for God's goodness to us and hope for us.
