


FCUCC March 2022 Newsletter

Lenten Season

Lent is the season in the church that begins on Ash Wednesday and helps us prepare for the celebration of Christ's Resurrection on Easter Sunday. Ash Wednesday traditionally has been a day set aside for reflection and confession. As a result, it is also a day of healing. Lent runs for 40 days, ending on Easter Sunday. The 40 days do not include Sundays, as each Sunday is considered it's own "mini" Easter. For some people, Lent is a time to **give up** something that takes away from your relationship with God. For others, it is a time to **add** something that may bring you closer to the divine.

This year, our Lenten journey will begin with Ash Wednesday on March 2nd, 2022. A separate Lenten Season flyer will be e-mailed and mailed to those without access in a couple weeks as we continue to work out the details regarding our services through the season.
