Pastor's Pondering

As we begin a process of discernment together, I would like to ask you all to pray daily with me for this church and specifically for the visioning team. Ask God to guide us. Where will we go? What do we, as a church, want to do for the community and the world? What are our gifts? We are the body of Christ and St. Teresa of Avila's words should echo in our lives.




