



Reopening COVID precautions FAQ

The steering committee has met and we are excited about re-opening for Easter Sunday. We realize the majority of our congregation has already been vaccinated, yet we want to do our best to minimize exposure for those that either have not or can not be vaccinated.

These are some of the procedures we will put in place for worshipping in person. This is not a full list, yet we hope that most of your questions will be answered. - We will continue to post recorded live worship on Facebook and YouTube after services sometime on Sunday. If you do not feel comfortable attending, we understand. Please use your own judgement
- Masks must be worn and 6' social distancing practiced at all times.

Upon Arrival...

- Please save the parking lot near the breezeway for folks that need elevator access. If you are able to walk, please use the main parking lot in front of the office when you arrive.
- Upon arrival please proceed to the breezeway for entering worship
- Temperatures will be taken outside before you enter the church facilities
- **To use elevator**, please use Bray Hall entrance. There will be markings 6 foot distance on the floor to line up to use the elevator in family groups
- **To use stairs**, please use the Education wing entrance and proceed up the stairs and through the Esther Kenodle Prayer loft to enter the sanctuary
- Bulletins and single-serve Communion (if applicable) will be available on tables as you enter the sanctuary.

- There will be a basket located with the bulletins for your offerings and tithes. Thank you for your continued support of our ministries!
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the church building.
- Water fountains will be unavailable until further notice. If you are in need of water please see one of the ushers
- Pews will be marked and staggered. The first two pews will not be available during services

Some helpful worship information...

- Hymnals and bibles will not be available during worship. Everything you will need to participate will be printed in the bulletins
- No corporate singing
- At this time we will not be able to enjoy our awesome choir, however we will be incorporating some solos and special music at a safe social distance during worship.
- The nursery will be closed indefinitely. We love a joyful noise and appreciate when families worship together! Please feel free to bring your children with you to worship as you are comfortable!

When departing....

- Please leave the card contained in your bulletin on the pew where you were sitting so our custodial staff can deep clean area. The card reads "This pew has been prayed upon"
- If using the elevator, please patiently line up using 6' distancing markings to exit
- If using stairs, please exit via stairs in Education wing (same way you entered worship)
- Please do not gather for social time after worship in the sanctuary or in Bray Hall.
