In this session, attendees will be introduced to the long-term negative effects construction and development can have on pre-existing trees. You'll learn what can be done before, during, and after a project to help preserve and protect the site's most valuable natural assets.

Precision Pruning

Friday, March 23rd 1:00pm-3:30pm

How has our understanding of trees changed over time, and how does that affect our pruning decisions? Ben Kappan will cover the science of arboriculture which has improved our pruning practices as we've learned more about how trees react to pruning. The success or failure of wound compartmentalization depends on the quality of pruning cuts. Precision pruning starts with proper cuts at natural targets. Extended into structural pruning, it leads to long-term success building more resilient trees.
