Cluster Box Units (CBUs) Information and Questionnaire

The United States Postal Service (USPS) has requested that Villas West modernize our mail delivery by installing cluster mailboxes (CBUs). Their concerns are efficiency and security of delivery. Mail delivery schedules are interrupted by pets, gates, and the lack of direct access to personal mailboxes. Many of our residents are concerned and inconvenienced having persons entering their private property and maintaining a clear path to the mailbox making a substantial portion of their patio unusable.

An ad hoc mailbox committee, organized in September 2020, met with the Post Office twice to discuss issues and options regarding implementing a centralized mailbox delivery.

- CBUs must comply with: USPS-4C guidelines (STD-4C), Postal Operations Manual (POM), Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), Fair Housing Act (FHA), ANSI 117.1, International Building Code (IBS) and Local Amendments.
- USPS maintains the CBUs and provides three keys per unit.
- Oversized packages will be delivered to the unit's front patio.
- If resident is unable to get to their CBU due to medical reasons, the Post Office has a system in place for home delivery.
- USPS has an online application for "Informed Delivery System" notification at no charge.
- There will be minimal cost to Villas West (installation of concrete pads).
