General: An Architectural Alteration Application, Form No. AAA, requesting the installation of a dryer vent through the villa rear wall or shed wall must be submitted to the Architectural Committee for review. The Architectural Committee will submit its recommendation to the Board of Directors for final approval.

Responsibility:

- 1. The dryer vent and installation workmanship shall always be the villa owner's responsibility and any leak, damage, repair or replacement from/of same, including the entire vent replacement if necessary, shall be at the villa owner's expense, both current and future owners. Additionally, any required dryer vent upgrade due to any subsequent building upgrade shall be the owner's responsibility and expense.
- 2. It is the owner's responsibility to properly maintain the dryer vent with respect to appearance and function.
- 3. At some point in time, should the owner decide to remove the dryer vent for whatever reason, an Architectural Alteration Application (Form No. AAA) must be submitted to the Board for approval. The wall opening must be returned to its original condition both inside and outside. This shall be the owner's responsibility and expense. The Architectural Chairperson along with the Maintenance Supervisor shall determine how this process is to be performed, monitor it, and sign off on it upon satisfactory completion.

NO HOLE SHALL BE LEFT IN THE WALL AT ANY TIME.

4. In cases of villa sale, any new owner must be informed of the dryer vent responsibility, and he/she must agree to it in writing by signing this document in the space provided.

Specifics:		
1. Approval must be obtained from the Board of Directors.		
2. The exterior part of the vent shall be plastic with a rodent access prevention screen on the bottom. Vent color shall be white for a white building wall and brown for a brick or wooden wall.
