Here's a checklist of how to get started:
Register online <u>www.firststatedance.org</u>
Make sure to pay the registration fee to reserve your spot in the class.
Come into FSDA with your child to purchase the required uniforms. Business hours are Monday-Thursday, 5:30-7:30pm. Please call for summer hours.
For the year-round classes, please be sure to read the parent handbook available on our website or at the front desk. This book tells you what to expect month to month.
Check the bulletin board through your parent portal, our dry-erase board in the lobby, emails, and/or texts for important information.
Be sure to choose monthly or semester payment options for tuition. The payment plan consists of 10 payments starting September thru June. <b>Everyone</b> must have some sort of payment information on file no matter which payment plan you chose.
Bring the dancer(s) to the studio, dressed and ready to take class! Be sure to follow the dress code so you won't receive a notice either verbally, by email, or by paper. If a student's hair is not in a bun or secure to their head(s), they will be sent downstairs to have it fixed. Have your child use the bathroom so they won't have to leave class.
Classes can be observed in the lobby on our televisions. Some have links to share with your spouses if they cannot be in the lobby. The lobby space is very small so we ask that one parent come with the dancer.
