

Ruach Chesed – A Spirit of Kindness and Mercy

Micah 6:6-8

Wherewith shall I come before YAHUAH, and bow myself before the high ELOHIYM? shall I come before him with burnt offerings, with calves of a year old?

Will YAHUAH be pleased with thousands of rams,

or with ten thousands of rivers of oil?

Shall I give my firstborn for my transgression, the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul? He has showed you, O man, what is good; and what YAHUAH requires of you, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your ELOHIYM?

Ruach: The decisions of man are connected to what he separates himself to.

Chesed: To extend Kindness and Mercy to someone opens a doorway that leads to a separated place, a refuge, where support and protection is offered.

Proverbs 31:26 She opens her mouth with wisdom; and in her tongue is the Torah of kindness.

Matthew 23:23-28 Woe unto you, scribes and Parashiym, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted nather weightier matters of the Torah: Judgment,

Mercy, and Faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave אאל other undone.

Ye blind guides, which strain את at a gnat, and swallow את camel.

Woe unto you, scribes and Parashiym, hypocrites! for ye make clean the outside of the cup and of the platter, but within they are full of extortion and excess.

You blind Parashiy, cleanse first that which is within the cup and platter, that the outside of them may be clean also.

Woe unto you, scribes and Parashiym, hypocrites! for ye are like unto whited sepulchres, which indeed appear beautiful outward, but are within full of dead men's bones, and of all uncleanness.

Even so ye also outwardly appear righteous unto men, but within ye are full of hypocrisy and iniquity.

Matthew 5:7 Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.

2 Peter 1:3-9 According as his divine power has given unto us all things אל that pertain unto life and holiness through the knowledge of him that has called us to glory and virtue: Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge;

And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience, holiness;

And to holiness, brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, love.

For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our **Adonai Yahusha Ha'Mashiach**.

But he that lacks these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and has forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

Hebrews 2:14-18 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also

himself likewise took part of the same; that through death את might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

For indeed he took not on him the nature of angels; but he took on him the seed of Avraham. Wherefore in all things it behooved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to **Elohiym**, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people. For in that he himself has suffered being tempted, he is able to help them that are tempted.

Psalm 56:8-13 You tell my wanderings: put my tears into your bottle: are they not in your cepher?

When I cry unto you, then shall my enemies turn back: this I know; for **Elohiym** is for me. In **Elohiym** will I praise his word: in **Yahuah** will I praise his word. In **Elohiym** have I put my trust: I will not be afraid what man can do unto me. Your vows are upon me, O **Elohiym**: I will render praises unto you. For you have delivered my soul from death: will not you deliver my feet from falling, that I may walk before **Elohiym** in the light of the living?
