- Investigate available commercial office, and/or shop, warehouse, yard & parking lot space with access to freeways.
- 1 Negotiate lease at the best cost & terms for new location.

- ✓ Determine what type of Internet access is available at new location. (Lead time for T1/Ethernet/fiber Circuits 4 to 6 wks.)
- ✓ Always have a signed lease, keys & landlord's consent to occupy prior to commencing TI, (Tennant Improvements).
- Do you have access to the building's electrical/telephone room, landlord's name, their contact info and business hours?
- Contact KCCi (714) 577-7777 or toll free (888) 524-6398 to transfer phone, fax & alarm T1, PRI, SIP & Internet circuits. 1
- Request proposals from KCCi for Structured Cabling & New Phone System, (hosted/cloud-based) & installation. Obtain floorplan of new location for furniture and to ensure wiring for the new location can be pre-installed properly. ✓
- ✓ Prepare new location for move-in. (essential inside wiring for telephone, computer, Internet, CCTV, PA speakers, etc.).
- 1 Plan for extra wiring drops. Consider extra Catagory 5, 5e, 6, 6a or 7 cable drops w/ RJ45s on each office wall.
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- Confirm server room requirements, electrical, flooring, HVAC, alarm, CCTV & dedicated space for tech equipment. 1 Contact the Municipality, (city, county or state) for change of address, business license and/or tax permits, etc.
- Purchase signs for new location or move existing signs & change lettering on company vehicles, if necessary.
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- Notify security "Alarm Company" insurance carriers, utility companies and other vendors of change of address. 1 Contract with a moving company for services. (Note: consider insurance for damage and/or breakage during move).
- 1 Arrange for extra help for packing and unpacking during move.
- Notify bank and credit card companies, trade organization of which you are a member of address change.
- Notify all customers & prospective customers of change of address and effective date.
- Have new business cards, envelops, letterhead, labels, marketing materials & checks printed to reflect address change.
- Change address on website & next year's phone book/yellow pages. (Not effective until new edition published).
- Request mail forwarding with U.S. Postal Service.
