#### **Dates & Hours:**

- Monday-Friday, 6:00 AM 6:00 PM
- Closed on July 4th

#### **Kamp Groups:**

- BE1: Ages 3-4
- BE2: Ages 5–12

#### **Activities Include:**

- Daily devotions, educational subjects, indoor/outdoor playgrounds
- Crafts, games, and activities
- Swim days and water fun
- Field trips (ages 5–12 only)
- Breakfast and snacks
- Sweet treats and more!

#### **Drop-Off & Pick-Up**

- Morning check-in is inside at the check-in station.
- Afternoon pick-up is in the same location. If children are outdoors, you must come inside to check out your child.
- Doors are locked between 9:00 AM 3:00 PM. Ring the doorbell for entry.
- Anyone picking up a child must be 18 years or older and show a valid photo ID.

#### **Dress Code**

- Kamp Shirts: Worn every Wednesday. If forgotten, parents may bring one by 9:30 AM or purchase a replacement shirt for \$15.
- Shorts/skirts/skorts: No more than 2 inches above the knee

- Closed-toe shoes encouraged; tennis shoes required on Thursdays
- Swimwear (Fridays):
- \* Girls: 1-piece or modest 2-piece tankini (no bikinis)
  - \* Boys: swim trunks (no cutoffs)
- Bring towel, bag for wet clothes, and life jacket if needed

#### **Meals**

- Breakfast: 7:00–8:00 AM (cold cereal or bar, fruit, milk/juice)
- Lunch: Must be packed cold, labeled in a zip lock bag, and placed in cooler. If forgotten, parents may bring one by 9:30 AM or purchase one for \$7.
- Snack: Provided daily from 3:00-3:30 PM

#### **Health & Safety**

- Medication form required; all meds labeled and locked.
- No meds in backpacks; staff carry meds during field trips.
- Illness policy: Must be 24 hours symptom-free before returning.
- Lice must be treated before return.
- Parents are notified of injuries immediately; incident forms required.
- COVID-19 guidelines followed for symptoms/exposure.

#### **Camper Conduct**

- Step 1: Verbal warning/time out
- Step 2: Parent notification
- Step 3: Parent-staff plan; possible loss of activities/field trips (no refunds)
- Continued issues may result in dismissal.

#### **Transportation**

- Sit facing forward at all times.
- Girls and boys may not sit together unless siblings.
- No food/gum; only water allowed.
- Campers help keep bus clean.

#### **Money & Purchases**

- Field Trip Money: Some venues have vending/gift shops.
- Candy Store: Daily options (\$1.50 each: chips, drinks, ice cream, candy).

#### **Electronics & Personal Items**

- Not allowed unless noted on calendar.
- No social media, recording, or photo sharing.
- Camp not responsible for lost/damaged items.

#### Sunscreen

- Each camper must bring labeled sunscreen.
- Counselors apply sunscreen before outdoor activities.
- Sunscreen not shared unless siblings.

#### **Payments & Fees**

- All payments are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Monthly payments: Due 1st; late after 2<sup>nd</sup> (5 PM). \$50 late fee + \$5/day/child.
- Weekly payments: \$40/day; due Friday before care begins.
- Late Pick-Up: \$1/minute after 6:05 PM; after 6:30 PM child taken to Edmond Police Department.
- Payments accepted Zelle or Check. Cash payments should only be given to the Director, Pastor, Supervisor only. Please do not give to Kamp Counselors.

#### **Emergencies**

- Fire, tornado, and emergency drills conducted monthly.
- Staff and campers trained on shelter locations.
- See Risk Management Manual for details.
