LONG-TERM VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Join one of the committees down below and become a part of the SFP Team. Committees meet once a month.

OUTREACH COMMITTEE

- Oversees advertising and marketing of the organization.
- Coordinates with Event Planning Committee on special events/projects.
- Manages/updates the SFP website and social media outlets.
- Researches potential conferences, markets, shows, and other events where SFP can set up an informational table.
- Recruits volunteers to help distribute flyers/posters, general research, ect.

EVENT PLANNING COMMITTEE

- Plans and implements fundraising, educational/awareness, and other special events.
- Coordinates with the Outreach Committee on event advertising and publicity.
- Seeks sponsorships and vendors for events.
- Collects silent auction/raffle items when needed.

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM COMMITTEE

- Collects and distributes food/essential needs to survivors.
- Coordinates temporary and long-term housing for survivors.
- Researches and maintains relationships with hotels/motels/apartments for temporary housing of survivors (rental discounts)
- Helps with transportation of survivors to appointments, SOS, grocery shopping, ect.
- Assists survivors with obtaining vital documentations, such as birth certificates, IDs, social security cards, ect.
- Helps provide childcare when needed.
- Recruits volunteers for Emergency Response Team.

MOBILE ART THERAPY PROGRAM COMMITTEE

- Planning and development of the SFP Art Therapy Program.
- Seeks grants/donations of art supplies and services.
- Recruits volunteers to help with transportation, gathering supplies, classroom assistance, set-up/clean-up, ect.
- Researches and builds listing of potential partnerships/collaborations.

MOBILE COUNSELING SERVICES PROGRAM COMMITTEE

- Planning and development of the SFP Counseling Services Program.
- Seeks grants/donations.
- Researches and builds listing of potential partnerships/collaborations

SHORT-TERM VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

- Oversee donation collection sites or collect needed items from donors.
- Organize and sort incoming donations at the SFP Office (The Nest).
- Prepare meals for survivors on an as needed basis.
- Assist with graphic designing of marketing materials (print & web).
- Volunteer at an event (photography, greeter, registration/sign-in table, set-up/tear-down, childcare, ect.)
- Assist with general administrative duties.
