Sparrow Freedom Project Hosts Expert Panel On The Realities Of Pornography And Human Trafficking

Metro Detroit, Michigan January 6, 2023 – On January 11, 2023 (Human Trafficking Awareness Day) at 5:00pm at Wayne State University on the Lower-Level Stage of the Student Center, Sparrow Freedom Project will host an expert panel discussion entitled "Exposed: The Realities of Pornography." The intent of this expert panel discussion is to heighten awareness around the prevalence of pornography in today's culture, and how and why it often leads to human trafficking.

The expert panelists include Chrissy Hemphill, Human Trafficking Specialist; Michelle Jarczewski, Assistant Prosecuting Attorney in Wayne County; Sgt. Nathan MacRae, City of Westland Police Department; and Kevin Outland, Speaker and Writer.

"Our expert panelists will be discussing what pornography is and what the illegal classifications of pornography are comprised of," said Executive Director, Tracey Cooley, Sparrow Freedom Project. Cooley went on to say that "the panel will also be discussing how pornography affects intimacy and relationships, and how this leads to addictions and harmful activities."

The panelists will round out their discussion, by engaging in a dialogue about the ultimate reality of pornography, which suggests a "responsible consumer of pornography" does not exist.
