This is a public service announcement to all of our AMAZING bingo players! Did you miss us? Because we sure missed you!

As previously posted, we are excited to announce that we are finally re-opening on October 9th, 2020. We never could have imagined that we would be closed for 210 days. As everyone should be aware by now, these are new and ever changing times. Because of this, in order for us to open, we have new rules and changes that employees, bingo workers, and players must follow. Our sincere hope is that you have missed the game so much that you are willing to do your part to help us stay open.

We know this announcement is lengthy, but please read it through in its entirety, and then read it again.

Our first session will be October 9th at 12:30 p.m. and doors will open at 11:00 p.m. There will be no progressive this session, as they had already played it before the closure in March. The progressive will continue at our Friday 6:30 pm session at \$4,938 in 52 numbers or less.

There are some temporary changes to times of opening. We will post a reminder when the session's progressive is posted on Facebook, so please pay attention. The following schedule will be until further notice.

- Sunday 6:30 p.m. session door opens 5:00 p.m.
- Monday 11:15 a.m. session door opens 9:30 a.m.
- > Monday 6:30 p.m. session door opens 5:00 p.m.
- > Tuesday 6:30 p.m. session door opens 5:00 p.m.
- Wednesday 6:30 p.m. session door open 5:00 p.m.
- > Thursday 6:30 p.m. session door opens at 4:30 p.m.
- Friday 12:30 p.m. session door opens at 11:00 a.m.
- Friday 6:30 p.m. session door opens at 5:00 p.m.
- > Saturday 12:30 p.m. session door opens at 11:00 a.m.
- > Saturday 6:30 p.m. session door opens at 4:30 p.m.

We are thrilled that MOST of our sessions decided to return. As you might have assumed, being closed for 210 days has been tough for these non-profits. Please be patient and kind to them as they navigate through these new waters.

Please notice the following changes. By entering through our doors, you are agreeing to follow ALL new rules. No exceptions.

- A face mask must be worn PROPERLY at all times. Per CDC guidelines, masks must cover nose and mouth, be secure under chin, and fit snug to the sides of face. Masks with an exhaust valve are not allowed. You may also wear a face shield in addition to your mask, but not by itself. The only exception to the mask rule is you may remove it while actively eating or drinking while seated at you table, then the mask must be properly replaced. Please do not abuse this rule, as the safety of the players and workers around you are extremely important to us. NO MASK, NO BINGO.
- ➤ We are currently limiting player capacity to 111 people for proper social distancing. There will be one player per table. Please don't move chairs.
- While lining up to enter the hall, please stand on the bingo balls which have been painted on the sidewalk. They indicate proper social distancing spacing.
- There is now only one entrance door. Upon entering, you will be temperature checked and asked some standard COVID-19 screening questions. Be sure that you can pass the standard COVID-19 screening questions and temperature check before you drive out here. You are required to give your name and phone number for contact tracing. A wristband will be given to be worn at all times. It lets the workers know you have been screened and keeps count of the number of people entering the hall.
- > When in the hall, we ask that you try to stay seated as much as possible. The workers will be calling groups up to buy your books according to the number on your wristband.

- Ticket sellers may be on the floor before bingo starts to reduce line size. The kitchen will also have someone on the floor to serve you when you get here.
- The doors will be closing in between sessions for the time being. In order for us to clean properly, we need all people and belongings out of the hall. If you choose to play another session, you will need to be screened and admitted again by the next bingo group.
- > There are many new signs around the hall for reminders to keep yourself and others around you safe. Please don't ignore them!
- Once capacity is met, a sign displaying NO ADMITTANCE will be placed at the door. If you see this sign, please do not ignore it and come in the hall.
- Social distancing stickers have been placed on the floor for the books, tickets and concession stand lines. Please remember to use them.
- If leaving the hall to smoke or go to your car, you need to use the EXIT ONLY door between the bathrooms and ticket counter. But remember, there is only one entrance door now to return back into the building. Please also social distance while outside.
- If you do exit, and already have a wristband for that session, you may proceed to the vestibule by the entrance door, the admittance worker will waive you through ahead of others in line who have not been admitted yet.
- Bingo groups will be dismissing players by tables or wristband number at the end of the session. It will help keep people apart while exiting through the doors.
- > As a courtesy to bingo workers, please place your own garbage in a receptacle at the end of a session as opposed to leaving it on the table.
- > As it was before the closure, we have enhanced our cleaning protocols before, during, and after a session.

- > If you choose not to follow the new rules after entering, you will be asked to leave. We are not taking any chances and won't risk the safety of the rest of the players and workers.
- > Everyone needs to work as a team for this hall to open. We hope with these protocols that you will feel safe during your visit. We are all in this together.
