Contest Rules and Regulations

Photographic entries:

- Photos must be taken in, or about, Mounds State Park.
- Entries sizes may not exceed 8” x 12”.
- Entries are NOT to be matted or mounted to any surface (paper, poster board, foam core, etc.) to assist staff in mounting work to the wall for judging.
- Entries should not have borders of any kind.

Poetry submissions:

- Entries should be **typed** on 8” x 11 ½ “ paper and be a uniform font size.
- Entries should not have the artist’s name printed, written, or anyway displayed on the face of the entry.
- Do not fold entries. If mailing your submission, please send in large flat mailing envelope.
- Poetry topics should be about Mounds State Park related topics (prehistory, Bronnenbergs, nature, etc.)
- Mounds State Park staff reserves the right to *not* display, or to re-produce, any entries deemed to fall outside of the above standards. If reproduced the entry will fit the above standards.

Hybrid Photo and Poetry submissions:

- Please read ***both*** the Poetry and Photo rules.

General Contest Rules

1. All submissions should have been created after January 1, 2021.
2. Each participant can submit a total of **3 works per category** with a maximum of 18 entries per person.
3. Due to the nature of the contest, we respectfully request that professionals refrain from participating in the juried competition.
4. Submissions can be turned in at the Mounds State Park Nature Center or via U.S. Postal Service along with entry form(s) and entry fee(s). Mailed submissions should be addressed to: Poetry and Photo Contest, Mounds State Park, 4306 Mounds Rd. Anderson, IN 46017. Mounds State Park shall not be held responsible for damaged or lost submissions.
5. The submitter shall retain all copyright(s) to submitted work. By entering this contest, the submitter consents to the use and publication of their work by Indiana Department of Natural Resources – State Park division, and specifically Mounds State Park in future promotional and educational materials. In addition, Friends of Mounds State Park, Inc. may publish works in fundraising efforts. IF your submission is selected for fundraising material, the artist will be provided two (2) complimentary copies of such material.
6. ***All physical submissions become the property of Mounds State Park.*** Submissions will not be returned to the artist.
7. The panel of judges will consist of local artists and community members. Decisions of the judges are final.
8. Juried winners will be announced at the Artists’ Reception held on Saturday March 19, 2022. A “People’s Choice” award will also be awarded, and that winner is selected by visitors to the park from March 19, 2022 through April 16, 2022. The “People’s Choice” winner will be notified by telephone or via email no later than May 1, 2022.
