Types of Baptism

Greek word used for Baptism is baptizō – properly, "submerge" (Souter); hence, baptize, to immerse (literally, "dip under"). It does not always mean water baptism. It means to be immersed in something.

1. Baptism into Christ
2. Baptism in the Holy Spirit
3. Baptism in Water

Baptism into Christ

1. We are clothed with Christ. We are hidden with Christ in God

Gal 3:26 You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. 27 For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ

Col 3:3 For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God.

2. Our Spirit becomes one with God's Spirit.

1 Corinthians 6:17 But whoever is united with the Lord is one with him in Spirit.

3. We become a new creation.

2 Cor 5:17 17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away. Behold, the new has come!

What happens when you are baptized into Christ

Romans 6:3-7.

3 Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? 4 We were therefore buried with him through Baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.

5 For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly also be united with him in a resurrection like his. 6 For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be done away with, a that we should no longer be slaves to sin— 7 because anyone who has died has been set free from sin

What happens when you are baptized into Christ

Let's start by looking at what happens when we are baptized into Christ

1. We are baptized into Christ Jesus.
2. We were baptized into his death.
3. We will live a new life
4. We were buried with him.
5. We will be resurrected
6. Our old self was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be done away with (rendered powerless)
7. We will no longer be slaves to sin

What happens when you are baptized into Christ

Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. Acts 2:28

1. He will forgive your sins. Acts 2:38
2. You will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit Acts 2:38

And now what are you waiting for? Get up, be baptized and wash your sins away, calling on his name.' Acts 22:16

3. He will wash away your sins.

What happens when you are baptized into Christ

Whoever believes in him and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. Mark 16:16.

4. You will be saved

For we were all baptized by one Spirit so as to form one body—whether Jews or Gentiles, slave or free—and we were all given the one Spirit to drink. (1 Cor. 12:13)

5. You are baptized into one body
6. You become part of the Family of God

Who is buried, who is crucified

Romans 6:6

"Knowing this, that our old self was crucified with Him, in order that our body of sin might be done away

The King James bible Reads

6 Knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin.

Baptism in the Holy Spirit

Acts 1:4-5

4 And while they were gathered together, He commanded them: "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift the Father promised, which you have heard Me discuss. 5 For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

This prophecy was fulfilled in Acts 2:4

4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

Evidence of the Baptism in the Spirit

1 Cor 12:4 4 There are different kinds of gifts (Charisma), but the same Spirit distributes them

1 Cor 12:7 Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good

"Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you." And with that He breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit." John 20:21-22

Evidence of the Baptism in the Spirit

1. Living Water Flows through you

Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, streams of living water will flow from within him." By this He meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were later to receive. Up to that time the Spirit had not been given since Jesus had not yet been glorified. John 7:38-39

Evidence of the Baptism in the Spirit

2. Gifts of the Spirit Manifest

No, this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel: "In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy. Acts 2:16-18 quoting Joel 2:28-32

I baptize you with water for repentance. But after me will come one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not fit to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire. Matthew 3:11

Gifts of the Spirit

2. Gifts of the Spirit Manifest

7Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good. 8To one there is given through the Spirit the message of wisdom, to another the message of knowledge by the same Spirit, 9to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit, 10to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another distinguishing between spirits, to another speaking in various tongues, and to still another the interpretation of tongues. 11All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, who apportions them to each one as He determines. I Cor 12:7-11

Evidence of the Baptism in the Spirit

3. Speaking in Tongues

When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them. Acts 2:1-4

3. Speaking in Tongues

Acts 10: 44 While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit came on all who heard the message. 45 The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astonished that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on Gentiles. 46 For they heard them speaking in tongues and praising God.

Acts 19:6-7: " When Paul placed his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came on them, and they spoke in tongues and prophesied.

What happens when we speak in Tongues

I Cor 13:1 if I speak in tongues of men or of angels. But do not have love. I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal

1 Cor 14:14 14 For if I pray in a tongue, my spirit prays, but my mind is unfruitful.

When we speak in Tongues our spirit is praying, our mind is not involved. Our spirit prays the things we need can also intercede

The apostle Paul prayed and sang in Tongues

1 Cor 14:15 What then shall I do? I will pray with my spirit, but I will also pray with my mind. I will sing with my spirit, but I will also sing with my mind.

Types of Tongues

Private Tongues

1 Cor 14:14 14 For if I pray in a tongue, my spirit prays, but my mind is unfruitful.

Public Tongues/ Tongues for interpretation

1 Cor 12:10 to another miraculous powers, to another prophecy, to another distinguishing between spirits, to another speaking in different kinds of tongues, and to still another the interpretation of tongues

Acts 2:22 "Fellow Israelites, listen to this: Jesus of Nazareth was a man accredited by God to you by miracles, wonders and signs, which God did among you through him, as you yourselves know

Acts 2:6 6 And when this sound rang out, a crowd came together in bewilderment, because each one heard them speaking his own language.

You will receive power to be His witnesses.

Acts 1:8 8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Receiving the baptism of the Holy Spirit



1. Repentance and baptism

Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off-- for all whom the Lord our God will call." Acts 2:38-39

Receiving the baptism of the Holy Spirit



2. Ask

If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!" Luke 11:13

Ask, and you will receive. You have not because you have not asked. James 4:2

1 Cor 12:31 Now eagerly desire the greater gifts. And yet I will show you the most excellent way.

1 Corinthians 14:1, "Follow the way of love and eagerly desire spiritual gifts, especially the gift of prophecy."

1 Cor 14:39 Therefore, my brothers and sisters, earnestly desire to prophesy, and do not forbid speaking in tongues.

3. Expect

This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us - whatever we ask - we know that we have what we ask of Him. 1 John 5:14-15

I tell you the truth, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart but believes that what he says will happen, it will be done for him. Therefore, I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours. Mark 11:23-24

4. Rest and Receive

Acts 10:44 While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit came on all who heard the message. 45 The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astonished that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on Gentiles. 46 For they heard them speaking in tongues and praising God.

Baptism in Water

Acts 8:36 Now, as they went down the road, they came to some water. And the eunuch said, "See, here is water. What hinders me from being baptized?"

38 So he commanded the chariot to stand still. And both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water, and he baptized him.

Baptism in Water

Matt 3:13 At that time, Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to be baptized by John. 14 But John tried to prevent Him, saying, "I need to be baptized by You, and do You come to me?" 15 "Let it be so now," Jesus replied. "It is fitting for us to fulfil all righteousness in this way." Then John permitted Him. 16 As soon as Jesus was baptized, He went up out of the water. Suddenly, the heavens were opened, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and resting on Him.

Deliverance is the children's bread.

Matthew 15:24 22 a Canaanite woman from that region came to Him, crying out, "Lord, Son of David, have mercy on me! My daughter is miserably possessed by a demon." 23 But Jesus did not answer a word. So His disciples came and urged Him, "Send her away, for she keeps crying out after us." He answered, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." 25 The woman came and knelt before Him. "Lord, help me!" she said. 26 But Jesus replied, "It is not right to take the children's bread and toss it to the dogs." 27 "Yes, Lord," she said, "even the dogs eat the crumbs that fall from their master's table." 28 "O woman," Jesus answered, "your faith is great! Let it be done for you as you desire." And her daughter was healed from that very hour.

The Deliverance Prayer

1. I ask forgiveness for my sins and the sins of my ancestors. (Be specific, and don't be in a hurry.) I repent for doing these things, and as an act of my will, I change my mind and choose to live according to your will and commandments. I ask you for your help to do this.
2. I believe that Jesus Christ died on the cross, and on the third day, He rose from the dead and is sitting with his Heavenly Father today.
3. I received his gift of forgiveness that was paid by the atonement he made for my sins on the cross.
4. I declare that Jesus Christ is my Savior and Lord.

The Deliverance Prayer

5. I choose to follow him in the waters of Baptism and identify with His cross by the act of Baptism, and by doing so, I choose to bury my old man and everything that is associated with him. These include all my sins, all my ancestors' sins, and all curses that were related to those sins.
6. I rebuke every spiritual force that's associated with my sins and my ancestors' sins.
7. In Jesus' name, I command these spiritual forces to go to the baptismal tank and never bother me again because you have no rights to me.

Sanctification

Eph 4:21-24 21 when you heard about Christ and were taught in him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus. 22 You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; 23 to be made new in the attitude of your minds; 24 and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.
