Provision for healing

Isaiah 53:5 & 1 Peter 2:24

24 "He himself bore our sins" in his body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; "by his wounds, you have been healed."

Jesus' declaration

Luke 4:18-20

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to

- 1. Preach the gospel to the poor he hath sent me to**
- 2. Heal the brokenhearted,**
- 3. Preach deliverance to the captives, and**
- 4. Recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,**
- 5. To proclaim the favorable year of the Lord."**

Three categories of healing

- 1. Physical healing: sight to the blind liberty to those that are bruised**
- 2. Heart healing: Emotional or mental issues.
Broken hearted & preach the gospel to the poor**
- 3. Spiritual healing: deliverance to the captives**

Heart Healing



1. brokenhearted.
2. the good news is proclaimed to the poor
 1. Poor: to be thoroughly frightened, to cower down or hide oneself for fear
 2. Good news: "gospelizing" It is about declaring the truth to people and breaking the lies that held them prisoner, for years

New Testament Words for Healing



1. *iaomia* (Strong's: G2390) is what we would consider an instantaneous miracle (32 occurrences)
2. *Therapeua* (Strong's: G2323) We get therapeutic from this word – So it means some therapy or process that results in healing and wellbeing (48 occurrences)
3. *Sozo* – (Strong's G4982) A word used to describe the healing of our spirits, souls, and bodies. To make you whole

Keys to Healing:



1. Authority

Mark 6:6-7

... Then Jesus went from village to village, teaching the people. And he called his twelve disciples together and began sending them out two by two, giving them authority to cast out evil spirits.

Luke 9:1-6

One day Jesus called together his twelve disciples and gave them power and authority to cast out all demons and to heal all diseases. So they set out and went from village to village, preaching the gospel and healing people everywhere.

Matthew 10:1

Jesus called his twelve disciples together and gave them authority to cast out evil spirits and to heal every kind of disease and illness.

4. Gifts of Healings

I Cor 12: 4-11

4 There are different gifts, but the same Spirit. 5 There are different ministries but the same Lord. 6 There are different ways of working, but the same God works all things in all people.

7 Now to each one, the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good. 8 To one there is given through the Spirit the message of wisdom, to another the message of knowledge by the same Spirit, 9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings- by that one Spirit

Keys to Healing:

6. Believe it is God's will to heal

Matthew chapter 8: 1-3

1 When Jesus came down from the mountainside, large crowds followed him. 2 A man with leprosy[a] came and knelt before him and said, "Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean."

3 Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. "I am willing," he said. "Be clean!" Immediately he was cleansed of his leprosy.

Examples of Jesus healing:

Physical healing

1. Luke 6:6-11

- Who Had Faith: Jesus
- What was Healed: Hand
- How Did Jesus Heal: He spoke to the man to stretch out his Hand?
- What did the person who was healed do: He stretched out his Hand
- Miracle or Progress: Miracle

2. Luke 18:35-42

Who Had Faith: Jesus

What was Healed: Eyes and vision

How Did Jesus Heal: He Spit on his eyes, He laid hands on him

What did the person who was healed do: He was honest that he was not instantly healed

Miracle or Progress: Progress. This is a twofold miracle.

Examples of Jesus healing:

Physical healing

3. Matthew 20:30-34

Who Had Faith: Two Blind men

How Did Jesus Heal: He was moved by Compassion. He touched their eyes

What did the person who was healed do: They shouted and asked him to heal them

Miracle or Progress: miracle.

Role of Faith in Healing

Rom 12:3

For by the grace given me, I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you.

Role of Faith in Healing

Rom 10:17

So then faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God

Role of Faith in Healing

Romans 4:17-22

17 As it is written: "I have made you a father of many nations." [a] He is our father in the sight of God, in whom he believed—the God who gives life to the dead and calls into being things that were not.

(God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did) KJV

Role of Faith in Healing



Mark chapter 11:22-24

22 “Have faith in God,” Jesus answered. 23 “Truly I tell you, if anyone says to this mountain, ‘Go, throw yourself into the sea,’ and does not doubt in their heart but believes that what they say will happen, it will be done for them. 24 Therefore, I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.

Literal translation is

And Jesus answering says to them, “Have faith from (of) God;
