Where Do We Learn God's Will?



1. God's Written Word: Logos

3. Holy Spirit

How Do We Receive God's Will,

2 "Moses my servant is dead. 1CH 28:11 Then David gave his son Solomon the plans for the portico of the temple, its buildings, its storerooms, its upper parts, its inner rooms and the place of atonement. [12] He gave him the plans of all that the Spirit had put in his mind for the courts of the temple of the LORD and all the surrounding rooms, for the treasuries of the temple of God and for the treasuries for the dedicated things.

Four keys to Hearing God



- 1. Stillness: Quiet our heart
- 2. **Vision**: Focus the eyes of our hearts on the Lord to see what He would say to
- Spontaneity: Recognize the word of the Lord is given as thoughts in our minds, choose to listen and see what the Lord would say to us
- 4. Journaling: Write down what we see and hear to share it with others.

Safeguard #2: Be accountable to someone What to Look for in a Spiritual Counselor:



- 1. A close friend, someone you trust, who will be honest with you.
- 2. One who knows the Lord, who is a Christian.
- 3. One who has a solid biblical orientation.
- 4. One who can sense the voice of the Spirit of God in his own heart.
- 5. One who is willing to commit himself to you, who will invest their time and energy in your growth,
- 6. Receives counsel themselves.
- 7. Is ahead of you in spiritual growth.

Safeguard #3: Beware Idols in Your Heart



"...any man in the house of Israel who sets up his idols in his heart, puts right before his face the stumbling block of his iniquity, and then comes to the prophet, I the Lord will be brought to give him an answer in the matter in view of the multitude of his idols." (Ezek. 14:4)

Types of Idols



1. Desires

Colossians 3:5 Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires, and greed, which is idolatry

- · A desire of the heart
- · Want of a position or a possession
- · The desire for sex.
- · lust for fame or credit
- · The desire for money,
- Unforgiveness toward those who have hurt you.
- · Desire for vengeance
- · Anything you want to hear

Safeguard #4: Let the peace of God Rule:

3. When we are Attacked



Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. I Peter 5:8

1. Satan

How you have fallen from heaven, O morning star, son of the dawn! You have been cast down to the earth, you who once laid low the nations! 2. Demons




3. The Flesh

4. The World



- · The lust of the flesh
- The lust of the flesh, lust for food, lust for sex, lust for wealth.
- The lust of the eyes
 - The lust of the eyes occurs when we see something visually that incites covetousness, jealousy, or sexual lust.
- · The boastful pride of life,
 - The pride of life is the desire in every human being to be their own god.
 - Arrogance, self-promotion, fame, and greed all stem from the pride of life.

4. The World

Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; a man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions." Luke 12:15

Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. Temptations of Christ



1. If you are the Son of God: Temptation: Undermine your True Identity

Galatians 4:6

Because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"

Romans 8:16

The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God,

Temptations of Christ



2. Use your power to make bread: Temptation: God is not your Provider.

"If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread." Jesus answered It is written, "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God." Matthew 4:3-4

And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus. Phil 4:19

"Therefore do not be anxious, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the Gentiles seek after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them all. But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you." Matthew 6:31-33

Temptations of Christ



3. Throw yourself down: Temptation: To receive Glory of Men

5 Then the devil took him to the holy city and had him stand on the highest point of the temple. 6 "If you are the Son of God," he said, "throw yourself down...

'You shall not tempt the Lord your God" Matthew 4:5-7.

Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Philippians 2:3

Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble. Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time. 1 Pet 5:5-6

Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall Proverbs 16:18

Temptations of Christ



4. Bow down and worship me: Temptation: To take the easy route to your purpose.

8 Again, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their splendor. 9 "All this I will give you," he said, "if you will bow down and worship me." Away with you, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve." Matthew 4:8-10

Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account. Heb 4:13

For there is nothing hidden that will not be disclosed, and nothing concealed that will not be known or brought out into the open. Luke 8:17

How to respond to Temptations



- 1. You have the authority
 - I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you. Luke 10:19
- 2. Submit yourself to God
 - Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. James 4:7
- 3. Resist the Devil
 - Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. Ephesians 6:17

How to respond to Temptations



- 4. By the Spirit put to death the desires of the flesh
 - For if you live according to the sinful nature, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live because those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. Romans 8:4,12-14
- 5. Beware of temptations
 - Temptations are very sneaky and start with just a simple feeling of dissatisfaction
 - a feeling of envy of someone else going on a holiday
 - · a feeling of agitation when someone gets promoted.
 - The feelings are the indicator of a temptation because they go from agitation to bitterness, to desire to see someone fail, to murder
 - · All sins are progressive and must be nipped in the bud.

Spiritual Weaponry



Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the Readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints. Ephesians 6:14-18
