Intimacy

An intimate relationship is a close interpersonal relationship.

It can be defined by these characteristics:

- · enduring interdependence,
- repeated interactions,
- emotional attachment, and
- a freedom to be transparent.

What happens when we become Intimate with God?

- 1. We develop a relationship with God as His children
- 1 John 3:1 "How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called the children of God"
- 2. We learn how to abide in Christ become dependent on the Lord 1 John 15:4 Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.
- 3. We are transformed by His Glory
- 2 Cor 3:18 And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate[a] the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.










Biblical Illustration

- 1CH 28:2 King David rose to his feet and said: "Listen to me, my brothers and my people. I had it in my heart to build a house as a place of rest for the ark of the covenant of the LORD,
- 1CH 28:11 Then David gave his son Solomon the plans for the portico of the temple, its buildings, its storerooms, its upper parts, its inner rooms and the place of atonement. How do know what we see and hear is from God

Analyze your thoughts (not all of them are yours)
Three categories of thoughts

- 1. Spontaneous Positive Thoughts = Holy Spirit
- 2. Spontaneous Negative Thoughts = demons
- 3. Analytical Thoughts = Self

2 Cor 10: [5] We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.





How to Test what you Hear

- 1. Does it line up with God's Word
 - o But the one who prophesies speaks to people for their strengthening, encouraging and comfort. 1Cor 14:3
- 2. Does it line up with the character of God
 - Taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed is the man who takes refuge in him Psalm 34:8
- 3. Does it line up with names of God
 - o Jehovah-Jireh (The Lord will provide) Genesis 22:14
 - o Jehovah-Raphe (The Lord my Healer) Exodus 15:26
 - o Jehovah-Nissi (The Lord my Banner) Exodus 17:15
 - o Jehovah-Shalom (The Lord my Peace) Judges 6:24
 - Jehovah-Raah (The Lord my Shepherd) Psalm 23:1
 - Jehovah-Tsidkenu (The Lord my Righteousness) Jeremiah
 23:6; 33:16

Safe Guard: Be accountable to someone What to Look for in a Spiritual Counselor:

- 1. A close friend, someone you trust, who will be honest with you.
- 2. One who knows the Lord, who is a Christian.
- 3. One who has a solid biblical orientation.
- 4. One who can sense the voice of the Spirit of God in his own heart.
- 5. One who is willing to commit himself to you, who will invest their time and energy in your growth,
- 6. Receives counsel themselves.
- 7. Is ahead of you in spiritual growth.

Session 3: Build Relationship: Spending time together



How do we Spend Time in His Presence

Soaking is a conscience decision to position ourselves to enter into the presence of the Lord

o HEB 4:8 For if Joshua had given them rest, God would not have spoken later about another day. [9] There remains, then, a Sabbath-rest for the people of God; [10] for anyone who enters God's rest also rests from his own work, just as God did from his. [11] Let us, therefore, make every effort to enter that rest, so that no one will fall by following their example of disobedience.





Soaking in the Bible?

ISA 40:31 But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Waiting or Soaking leads to:

- a) Blessing
- b) Renew your strength (strength of Body, Soul, Spirit)
- c) Soar on wings like an Eagle (you see from God's perspective)
- d) Run and not grow weary (the race set before us)
- e) Walk and not faint (tire of doing good)
- f) Communication/Revelation as still and in receiving mode can lead to healing, understanding, new places from God. Deeper revelation of His Spirit



How do I start soaking

- 1. Dump the business of the day on the note pad, so you don't have to think about it. Don't worry if you keep thinking of things, just keep writing them down. The parade will eventually pass
- 2. Fix your eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of your Faith. Bill recommends imagining a Bible story that Jesus is in as way to get focused on the Lord.
- 3. Play some quiet music. This helps our brain to start tuning into the intuitive side of our brain. Prophets of old would call for a musician to quiet themselves down. 2 King 3: [15] But now bring me a harpist." While the harpist was playing, the hand of the LORD came upon Elisha





How do I start soaking

- 4. We can talk to God about what we are feeling and listen to what he says. We can ask him what he would like to say to us.
- 5. God may remind of sins or situations. The best solution in this case is repentance and forgiveness.
- 6. Some may not feel anything but many feel God's presence in waves coming over them wave after wave



Benefits of Soaking

- 1. Joshua never left the tabernacle was continually soaking in the presence of God. When He went into the enemies camp, he saw different, he saw with God's eyes. We too will start to situation with God's perspective Ex 33:11
- 2. You will be filled with the Holy Spirit
- 3. You will become like the one you hang out with (Your Heavenly Father)
- 4. When you get filled with His presence it will change the atmosphere of your work, church, home, because his glory will radiate out of you





Benefits of Soaking


- 5. Renewal continues. Revival keeps coming at CTF because God's people keep coming hungry and thirsty
- 6. We need to be full to minister otherwise we minister out of the flesh. Soaking prevents this.
- 7. You develop intimacy with God

Psalm 35 Of David. Be Real with God

- 1 Contend, Lord, with those who contend with me; fight against those who fight against me.
- 2 Take up shield and armor; arise and come to my aid.
- 3 Brandish spear and javelin[a] against those who pursue me. Say to me, "I am your salvation."
- 4 May those who seek my life be disgraced and put to shame;
- may those who plot my ruin be turned back in dismay.
- 5 May they be like chaff before the wind, with the angel of the Lord driving them away;
- 6 May their path be dark and slippery, with the angel of the Lord pursuing them.
- 7 Since they hid their net for me without cause and without cause dug a pit for me,
- 8 May ruin overtake them by surprise— may the net they hid entangle them, may they fall into the pit, to their ruin.9 Then my soul will rejoice in the Lord and delight in his salvation.

- 7 Set me free from my prison, that I may praise your name.





Theme: Unworthiness, Guilt, Shame UGB I am not worthy to receive anything from God.


Theme: Doing to Achieve Self-worth, Value, Recognition UGB I will never get credit for what I do.

Theme: Control (To avoid hurt)
UGB I have to plan everyday of my life. I have to continually
plan/strategize. I can't relax.

Theme: Physical UGB I am unattractive. God short-changed me.



Belief Expectation Cycle







12 results of ungodly beliefs

- 1. They can contribute to a poor self-image.
- 2. They determine our significance and security
- 3. They affect how we approach God in prayer;
- 4. They determine our behaviour;
- 5. They are spiritually corrosive,
- 6. They block the truth of God
- 7. They keep us from walking in the truth of Christ. The battle is in the mind.
- 8. They enable us to cover our weakness,
- 9. They lead us to build up defenses,
- 10. They lead us to develop prejudice of other people groups.
- 11. We can use ungodly beliefs to justify ourselves and our behaviors/actions
- 12. They can lead to striving, or performance orientation.



Behaviour of a wounded heart

- o Insecurity comes from a wounded heart that is not secure in their true identity and they draw their identity from their job, title or role
- o They may introduce themselves by their title instead of their name.

- o If you challenge them or threaten their position they go on the defensive
- o They are insecure to raise up other people considering them as threats





Behaviour of a wounded heart

o They put themselves forward and suppress other

 They will rarely speak a word of blessing or encouragement



Behaviour of a secure heart

- A secure person acts quite different
- They raise up others that have the same anointing and calling they do
- o They open doors for them and provide the opportunities
- o They coach them and invest time in them
- o They rejoice when their protégée exceeds them in their field



Behaviour of a secure heart

A secure person acts quite different

- o They speak life and hope into others
- o They words of destiny and affirmation who are the same sphere of the kingdom as they are. These words produce tremendous results





God's solution to understanding our feelings

The Lord spoke to me a verse of Scripture from John 5:39,40. He said, "you search the Scriptures, because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is these that bear witness of me; and you are unwilling to come to Me, that you may have life."





Three sources of feeling

1. Ourselves:

We feel joy, love, happiness, pride of a job well done, confidence, peace, sadness, depression, anger, lust etc. Some of these feelings are good some may be coming from our own woundness Phil4:7 And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus

2. Demonic: Defilement;

2 Pet2:7 and if he rescued Lot, a righteous man, who was distressed by the filthy lives of lawless men

3. God: Burden Bearing:

Phil 3:10 I want to know Christ and the power of his resurrection and the fellowship of sharing in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death





Three sources of feeling

3. God: Revelation: Discernment

Mark 2:8 Immediately Jesus knew in his spirit that this was what they were thinking in their hearts, and he said to them, "Why are you thinking these things?

3. God: Discernment of evil:

Acts 16:18 She kept this up for many days. Finally Paul became so troubled that he turned around and said to the spirit, "In the name of Jesus Christ I command you to come out of her!" At that moment the spirit left her

3. God: Discernment of Good:



Sonship Declaration

- *I reject all false identities
- ❖I embrace my true identity, I am a son(or Daughter) of God
- *I put on the Signet ring of the Lord.





God is our Father

Rom 8:[15] For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father." [16] The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children. [17] Now if we are children, then we are heirs-heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.

JN 16:25 "Though I have been speaking figuratively, a time is coming when I will no longer use this kind of language but will tell you plainly about my Father. [26] In that day you will ask in my name. I am not saying that I will ask the Father on your behalf. [27] No, the Father himself loves you because you have loved me and have believed that I came from God.

He has no favorites

He gives good gifts

He has not religious, he is your Dad

Lies about the Father

He has plans to hurt you or destroy you

You have to earn His love

Some people are special to God and some are not.

He gives sickness, failure, trial

He withholds what you really wants, takes away what you love He gives death and misery

He loves religion and requires pomp and title and position






Praying With An Idol







- o Acknowledged Thomas lack of faith and offered his hand to see put his fingers in the holes to build up his faith






3. Jesus demonstrated the Kingdom over the world



How do I live in the Kingdom of God

- o I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high." Luke 24:49
- o Acts 1:4 4 On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. 5For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

1st Empowering of the Holy Sprit

Anointing

- 1. Shepherds: Protect sheep's ears and heal their wounds
- 2. Kings, Prophet Priest: Anointed For purpose or role
- 3. Chosen One: Jesus Christ anointed by God to spread the Good news. We are little Christs (Christians) with the same mandate
- 4. It is an enabling gift or power to fulfill a ministry or the work of the kingdom

New Testament Greek words for "anoint" are chrio, which means "to smear or rub with oil, and by implication to consecrate for office or religious service"; and aleipho, which means "to anoint."





Facts about the Anointing

It is more than symbolic, it is real,

- You can feel it, it has weight, it is thick,
- You can pour it out,
- You can throw it

Jesus used the anointing to the work of his ministry;

- Walked on the water
- o Turned water into wine
- Fed the 5000 extravagantly
- He multiplied fish



The Challenge of the Anointing

Samuel anointed both David and Saul.

15A 16:13 So Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the presence of his brothers, and from that day on the Spirit of the LORD came upon David in power. .

Humility is a critical component to handling an increase in the anointing



Challenges of the Anointing

You can blow it.

15A 15:17 Samuel said, "Although you were once small in your own eyes, did you not become the head of the tribes of Israel? The LORD anointed you king over Israel.

Saul fell when he was no longer looked at himself as small in your own eyes.



Challenges of the Anointing

o The most dangerous person in the Kingdom of God is an gifted anointed person who has wounded heart

Warning:

 Remember to stay little in your own eyes. We are just donkeys that carry the presence of the King

o Our Motto is must be lower still





The anointing is increasing

- The church is morphing from an organization into an organism. The five fold ministry is restored
- o the open Christianity movement that primarily means house churches, are very active
- o The participant base of the church, the number of believers taking active roles, has expanded by a factor of perhaps 100





The anointing is increasing

- o Church growth outside of America is now breathtaking. Every morning, there are 175,000 more Christians in the world. And if current growth rates (8% a year) were to continue, everyone in the world would be a core apostolic Christian by 2032
- The bottom line: The world is rapidly becoming all Christian.



Iran Has the World's Fastest Growing Church: the Iranian awakening

- o People in Iran, a Muslim-majority nation, are fleeing Islam in droves as believers bow their knee to Jesus and become aggressively pro-Israel,"
- o "What if I told you the mosques are empty inside Iran?" he continues. "What if I told you no one follows Islam inside of Iran? Would you believe me? This is exactly what is happening inside of Iran. God is moving powerfully inside of Iran."
