Sanctuary



- 1. In Heaven: Hebrews 8:1-2.
 - Now the main point of what we are saying is this: We do have such a high priest, who sat down at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in heaven, 2 and who serves in the sanctuary, the true tabernacle set up by the Lord, not by a mere human being.
- 2. In his church: (2 Corinthians 6:16). 16 What agreement is there between the temple of God and idols? For we are the temple of the living God. As God has said:"I will live with them and walk among them, And I will be their God, And they will be my people."

- 3. In a Believer: (1 Corinthians 3:16).
 16 Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in your midst?
- In New Jerusalem: Revelation 21:22.
 22 I did not see a temple in the city because the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple.

Why Worship



He is worthy of our worship.

What happens when we worship



1. The Glory of The Lord fills the Place of Worship

The trumpeters and singers joined in unison, as with one voice, to give praise and thanks to the Lord. Accompanied by trumpets, cymbals, and other instruments, they raised their voices in praise to the Lord and sang: "He is good; His love endures forever." Then the temple of the Lord was filled with a cloud, and the priests could not perform their service because of the cloud, for the glory of the Lord filled the temple of God. II Chronicles 5:13-14

2. Worship transforms us.

3. We recognize we are not Holy and confess our sins

Seven Hebrew words translated Praise

Seven Hebrew words translated Praise



- 1. Halal: To jump, dance, to be loud and clamorous Psalm 150:2

 Praise him for his acts of power; praise him for his surpassing greatness.
- Yadah: To throw your hands up and forward while making a confession about God Isaiah 25:1 Lord, you are my God; I will exalt you and praise your name, for in perfect faithfulness you have done wonderful things, things planned long
- 3. Towdah: To lift your hands in thanksgiving Joshua 7:19
 Then Joshua said to Achan, "My son, I implore you, give glory to the
 LORD, the God of Israel, and give praise to Him; and tell me now what
 you have done. Do not hide it from me." NASB

Seven Hebrew words translated Praise



- 4. Shabach: A loud, joyous shout of testimony Psalm 145:4

 One generation shall praise thy works to another, and shall declare thy mighty acts
- 5. Zamar: To worship the Lord while playing an instrument Psalm 98:4 Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all the earth: make a loud noise, and rejoice, and sing praise.
- 6. Barak: To kneel in reverence and submission Ps 72:15 15 And he shall live, and to him shall be given of the gold of Sheba: prayer also shall be made for him continually; and daily shall he be praised.

Seven Hebrew words translated Praise


Tehillah To sing a spontaneous, unrehearsed song of the Lord, from your spirit Psalm 22:3
