Solos/Duos/Trios

Solos/Duos/Trios- Please remember that doing a solo/duo/trio is a privilege! Dancers must have good attendance to be allowed to dance an extra piece for recital. Any solo/duo/trio dancers must have two private lessons before recital with an instructor of their choosing. Cheyenne Bull also must watch and approve their piece. Cheyenne will need to hear the music and see a printout of your lyrics

(dancer is responsible for this) for approval before it is added to the program. You must get the cut music to Cheyenne so it can be put on the recital playlist. The deadline for approval of any dance pieces to be included in our recital will be May 1st, 2021.

Please make sure you show up at least ten minutes before your scheduled time with hair and makeup done. We are on a tight schedule, and if you are late you might miss out on the class pictures. The class picture will NOT be retaken. If you are unable to attend your scheduled picture time for any reason, please let Cheyenne know as soon as possible. This year we are having Sandy Harden do our pictures. She has been doing pictures since 2004 and started her own studio in 2012. Sandy will be accepting cash and check. The checks will be made out to Focused Girl Photography. Please let Cheyenne know if you have any questions about pictures.

Tights, Shoes
