

Corporate Membership

- 1. There will be one Primary and up to two Associate members from a business. The corporate entity will determine who is the Primary and who is the Associate(s).
- 2. All proposed members will go through the normal process to become Rotarians (including Fireside Chat, Orientation, Red Badge/Blue Badge procedure, etc.). The goal is to make sure that each member understands Rotary and our club.
- 3. Both Primary and Associate members will be treated like any individual member participate on a committee, serve as Rotarian of the Week, etc.
- 4. There can be a maximum of two members of any business on any committee.
- 5. Any mandatory fundraisers can be spread across the Corporate Members. For example, 4 mums are required to be sold. If the Primary member sells 3 and an Associate member sells one, then minimum is met. The corporate donation is considered to be in lieu of the Associates' Individual Fundraising requirement.
- 6. The cost for Corporate Membership is \$2,000 per year (can be paid yearly or \$500 per quarter).

Breakdown:

Primary \$600 Associate (for up to 2) \$500 Donation to the club (in lieu of Associates' fundraising) \$900 Total \$2,000

- 7. For Rotary membership purposes, the Primary member and Associates will be treated as individual members. However, the billing will be to the business, not to the individual Primary member or Associate(s).
- 8. These costs cover one meal per meeting. If two or more Corporate members attend, there is a per-meal charge for each in excess of the first. This will be tracked by the Sergeant-at-Arms and billed by the Treasurer along with the quarterly dues.
- 9. If an Associate member leaves his or her business, the business can designate a replacement, whose membership will be subject to the full onboarding process.
- 10. If an Associate member leaves the business, he or she can remain in the club by transferring to individual member status.
- 11. If there are currently multiple members of the same organization, they will be permitted to transition to a Corporate membership.
