John 3:16-17 Says, "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life; **for God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.**"

Many have turned to God so they wouldn't perish in their sin. But, the real focus and purpose of these verses is "Everlasting Life", "Believing God" and knowing "God's Not Now Condemning Us" The Biblical meaning of "Everlasting Life" is found in **John 17:3**, "And this is life eternal, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent; it's knowing Him intimately – that's true "Everlasting Life!" Once you know Jesus you have everlasting life right then!

"**Believing God**" is not knowing facts about Jesus; it's an intimate knowledge from the heart. Like a man "knows" his wife or children. Belief in God must come how it is described in **Romans 10:10** "**For with the heart one believes unto righteousness** and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." A person **IS NOT SAVED** by knowing that God exists, for **James 2:19** declares, "You believe that there is one God. You do well; **even the demons believe and tremble.**" So the demons believe there is a God, but they aren't saved. God isn't mad at us, or condemning us. **Romans 8:1** says "There is therefore **NOW no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus...**"

Ask yourself this question: "**If you were to die today, what qualifies you for heaven according to these verses?**" **Now, let me ask you another question**, "Where is your heart after reading these verses?"

Are you ready to turn to Jesus and do things His Way? Jesus says, **Repent for the Kingdom of God is at Hand. If you are ready to repent and accept Jesus Way, then tell Jesus what is in your heart.** Use your own words and mean it from your heart.

Fancy prayers, not required. When I was saved (born again), I was all alone and my only prayer was "Lord help me". But, in my heart, I knew with certainty I wanted to do things God's Way and not my way. I got the courage to pray because I had compassion on someone else and somehow that activated my faith.
