Work Session Minutes

Monday, October 17, 2022 @ 5:00pm

Chairman Bradich called the Work Session to Order October 17, 2022 @ 5:00pm

At 5:02 Trustee Benton motioned to adjourn the Regular Meeting of October 10, 2022. Motion was seconded by Trustee Jett.

The Work Session was called to order at 5:03pm. There was discussion with Resident Jason Dawson regarding updating the website. Mr. Dawson offered his expertise in assisting the Village with potentially adding a calendar of events and making the website more user friendly. There was discussion on recording/live streaming Regular Board Meetings and how to best administrate that task. Discussion on sound and making sure the public will be able to hear everyone who speaks. There was discussion about the necessity of livestreaming meetings during flu season and times of higher risk of covid, etc.. There was discussion regarding if AARP fund could help fund this since it is a public health/safety matter. There was discussion about the Policy Manual. It is currently being reviewed and the Department Heads are still discussing changes that need to be made.

Trustee Hoppe discussed a Mitten Tree for the Christmas Season. This would be a tree in City Hall where people could donate mittens, gloves, scarves, etc. for those in need. There was discussion on how to reach out to our community to make sure every citizen has what they need to stay warm. Discussion on potentially reaching out to our local schools who have students in need. Discussion regarding putting contact information on our website for those in need to be able to access. Discussion on wrapping the donated items to keep them clean.

Police Chief Coonce discussed our code of ordinances and that that he is working on remapping and updating our ordinances with MSHP Chargecodes in PD software to be more complete.

Chief Coonce also discussed the K9 Car and the need for a camera in it.

Chief Coonce also discussed the need to update our video software system to make it more accessible to those requesting video. The software would eliminate the need for multiple people to be handling cameras, dvds, etc. It would make recovery and duplication of video faster and more efficient.


Discussion on the AARP fund and what areas the Village can use these funds in.

Fire Chief Shaumeyer discussed new grants available in regards to a trailer for fire simulation training. He discussed other grants available.

Fire Chief Shaumeyer discussed the need for new gear. There was discussion on a way to offer employees ability to buy/sell used gear. Chief Shaumeyer said his biggest need in the department was a new engine on a 1995 Pierce-Dash. Chief Shaumeyer informed the board on significant plumbing issues at the station. They currently getting bids on diagnosis and repair.

Court Administrator Coonce informed the board on the recent changes that have been made in the court. The internet connectivity issues and how the court is actively working to be compliant with the OSCA in all areas.

Acting Village Clerk Wymore updated the board on areas that are being corrected in City Hall. She is working with the State and County to correct issues.
