From Police Chief Coonce

Sec. 27-207. - Prohibited parking during snow emergencies.

(a) Whenever snow has accumulated or there is a possibility that snow will accumulate to such a depth that snow removal operations will be required, the chairman of the board of trustees or such other person as shall be designated by the board of trustees, may declare a parking emergency, and until such an emergency is terminated and the snow removed from the streets, no vehicle shall be parked on any street or the right-of-way of any street in the village.

(b) All vehicles parked on such street at the time of the declaration of such emergency shall be moved. Provided, however, that the village shall take reasonable action to notify owners/operators of motor vehicles that such emergency has been declared.

Dog License Renewals

The Village of Claycomo Code of Ordinances, Section 7-52, requires a fee for each dog owned by a resident. This fee is \$5.00 for dogs that have been spayed or neutered and \$10.00 for any dog that has not been spayed or neutered. We know there are still several dogs in the

Village that are not yet licensed. Officers will be ticketing dog owners whose dogs are found without a license. The form is available by download <https://claycomo.org/licenses-and-permits>. There are also forms available at City Hall.




