

The Village of Claycomo Code of Ordinances, Section 7-52, requires a fee for each dog owned by a resident. This fee is \$5.00 for dogs that have been spayed or neutered and \$10.00 for any dog that has not been spayed or neu-

tered. We know there are still several dogs in the Village that are not yet licensed. Officers will be ticketing dog owners whose dogs are found without a license. The form is available by download https://claycomo.org/licenses-and-permits. There are also forms available at City Hall.
