RIDE-ALONG PROGRAM

The Ride-Along Program of the Claycomo Police Department is designed to provide citizens with the opportunity to observe law enforcement in action and become familiar with Department patrol procedures.

Participants of the Ride-Along Program become the responsibility of the Police Officer with whom they ride. Participants are asked not to leave the patrol car on specific police assignments unless their assistance is requested by the Police Officer with whom they are riding. This policy is necessary to protect the citizen from any eventuality of bodily harm, no matter how remote. The role participants play is strictly that of an observer. They may not become involved verbally or physically with any suspects the Police Officer questions or with whom the Police Officer comes in contact.

Citizens over the age of seventeen (17) may participate once every six (6) months. Citizens who have graduated from a Police Academy may participate once every three (3) months.

The Department requires that all participants be neatly attired when riding in a police vehicle. The accepted mode of dress is shoes, shirt/blouse, slacks and jacket/coat when applicable.
