Q&A

Why did you choose those days and times? There is limited parking in front of the building; to ensure our neighbor's customers aren't burdened with finding a place to park.

Are you accepting donations? Yes. We accept monetary donations anytime. During our open house we will accept donations of plastic shopping bags, canned goods, diapers, cleaning supplies, toiletries and soft goods donations such as gently used and clean clothes, towels, sheets, tablecloths, etc.

Are there items you can't accept? At this time, we can not accept furniture donations or household donations that are considered 'hard goods' such as plates, glasses, silverware etc.

Please do not be offended if we can not accept your donation. It's not personal, we are a small team of volunteers who only have so much time and energy to dedicate. Later in the future, we hope to expand and accept more items.

Who is invited to attend? We encourage all Claycomo residents, businesses, and surrounding neighborhoods to attend.

Are you serving any food? Snacks will be provided.

What are the pantry's normal business hours? The Big Blue Pantry will be open 1 day a week. That day is to be determined and will be announced at the open house. We will expand hours in accordance with the current needs of the community and the availability of volunteers.

Will the Little Pantry, located outside of Claycomo city hall, still operate? Yes. We will continue to fill the Little Pantry but selections will be limited.
