Winter is almost here again, so I just want to remind you of our Snow Removal parking ordinance.

## Sec. 27-207. Prohibited parking during snow emergencies.

(a) Whenever snow has accumulated or there is a possibility that snow will accumulate to such a depth that snow removal operations will be required, the chairman of the board of trustees or such other person as shall be designated by the board of trustees, may declare a



parking emergency, and until such an emergency is terminated and the snow removed from the streets, no vehicle shall be parked on any street or the right-of-way of any street in the village.

(b) All vehicles parked on such street at the time of the declaration of such emergency shall be moved. Provided, however, that the village shall take reasonable action to notify owners/operators of motor vehicles that such emergency has been declared.

Some of you may be unaware of a service our Police Department provides to our residents. We have a Residence Check form available at City Hall that can be filled out when you go out of town. This form provides information on when you are leaving and returning, if your lights are on a timer, who has business on the property while you are gone and who to contact in case of an emergency. Our officers check your property several times a day while you are away. Many people worry about their property while they are absent, this residence check service may bring you some peace of mind on your next trip. All information is confidential. Please remember to call us and cancel the check when you return.

## **Dog License Renewal Time**

The Village of Claycomo Code of Ordinances, Section 7-52, requires a fee for each dog owned by a resident. This fee is \$5.00 for dogs that have been spayed or neutered and \$10.00 for any dog that has not been spayed or neutered. Owners are required to provide a copy of each

dog's current rabies vaccination at the time of application (Sec 7-54).

Licenses are valid from January 1 through December 31 of each year and MUST be affixed to the collar of the dog (Sec 7-57). Any license purchased after January 31 shall carry a late penalty of \$2.50. Residents that take ownership of a dog after January 31st of said year, has 60 days to license the dog before a penalty is assessed. If tag is lost, a replacement tag can be acquired, at a cost of \$2.50. If your pet is not properly registered and/or the tag is not affixed to its collar you may also be cited a nuisance violation that may incur court fees. Dogs deemed vicious will not be permitted to be licensed in the Village of Claycomo.

We will start accepting applications for 2024 licenses on December 1st. The form is available by download on our website, by visiting <a href="https://claycomo.org/licenses-and-permits">https://claycomo.org/licenses-and-permits</a>. There are also forms available at City Hall.


