



**MINUTES OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES REGULAR MEETING
AUGUST 11, 2025

Meeting Start: Chairman Bradich called the Regular Meeting of August 11, 2025, to order at 7:00 PM.

Trustee Jett led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Trustee Benton motioned to approve the Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting of July 28, 2025; Trustee Barrera seconded. Roll call: Trustee Barrera: Yea, Trustee Jett: Yea, Trustee Benton: Yea, Trustee Keelin: Yea, Chairman Bradich: Yea. Motion carried.

Trustee Jett motioned to approve the Payment of Bills for July 24, 2025, through August 7, 2025, seconded by Trustee Keelin. Roll call: Trustee Barrera: Yea, Trustee Jett: Yea, Trustee Benton: Yea, Trustee Keelin: Yea, Chairman Bradich: Yea. Motion carried.

Village Clerk Wymore read the First Reading of Bill Number 3070 by title only AN ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 3020: AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CLAYCOMO MISSOURI, TO ESTABLISH A PROCEDURE TO DISCLOSE THE POTENTIAL CONFLICTS OF INTEREST AND SUBSTANCIAL INTEREST FOR CERTAIN MUNICIPAL OFFICES.

Trustee Barrera asked how this changes the current ordinance. Clerk Wymore explained that it does not change anything. Every 2 years, it must be reenforced by the Board.

Village Clerk Wymore read the Second Reading of Bill Number 3070, Ordinance 3069, by title only AN ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 3020: AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CLAYCOMO MISSOURI, TO ESTABLISH A PROCEDURE TO DISCLOSE THE POTENTIAL CONFLICTS OF INTEREST AND SUBSTANCIAL INTEREST FOR CERTAIN MUNICIPAL OFFICES.

Trustee Barrera motioned to approve Bill Number 3070 to become Ordinance Number 3069. Trustee Jett Seconded. Roll call: Trustee Barrera: Yea, Trustee Jett: Yea, Trustee Benton: Yea, Trustee Keelin: Yea, Chairman Bradich: Yea. Motion carried.

- Trustee Barrera: Congratulated Chief Coonce on his son's marriage, last week. He brought up the recent uptick in violence against law enforcement (shootings). He knows that our officers are well-trained and prepared but wanted to share his concern. He had a resident complaint about people that are attending events in the Community Building, parking on both sides of Drake Street and walking down the middle of the road, making it difficult for residents to get home. Chief Coonce assured him that he would see who was on duty over the weekend. Chairman Bradich revisited placing NO PARKING signs on the street. It will have to be researched further.
- Trustee Jett: Asked how many dogs are registered in the Village. Village Clerk Wymore said she would get back to him with that number.
- Trustee Benton: Warns of wild animals (possibly coyote) around the village. Don't approach. Call it in.
