- SCORE highlights innovative practices and initiatives to support educators


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# Staffing needs are localized and vary by geography and endorsement area

 Special education, ESL, world languages, early childhood, and secondary math experience the highest vacancy rates





# Staffing challenges remain as leaders issue emergency credentials to staff vacancies

- Teacher vacancies have increased
- Permits have more than doubled, but are also available to more teachers

# Administrators express challenges staffing open positions with high-quality teachers

 Rural district leaders overwhelmingly do not believe Tennessee's pipeline produces enough effective teachers

How challenging is it to recruit the following kinds of teachers to your school?	Admin reporting challenges
Instructionally effective teachers	65%
Teachers with necessary qualifications for vacancies	64%
Teachers who will stay at my school	52%
Racially/ethnically diverse teachers	71%



## Many students do not have access to a reliable, effective, and diverse educator pipeline

Disparate access to qualified and experienced teachers based on income

Teacher Experience and Licensure	High-Poverty Schools	Low-Poverty Schools
Inexperienced teachers	24.1%	13.3%
Teachers with temporary permits	3.6%	0.3%
Teachers with endorsement exemptions	0.7%	0.2%




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#### Tennessee's Future Teacher Scholarship

- TCA 49-4-701
- Last dollar scholarship to cover EPP tuition and fees
- Undergraduate junior/senior teacher candidates
- Tennessee HOPE eligible
- 4-year teaching commitment
- High needs counties and subject areas of shortage



#### Challenges with Scholarship Access

- Limited number of teacher candidates are eligible
- Scholarship amounts are unclear
- Teaching commitment does not mirror the award
- Difficulty planning four years after graduation



### SB682/HB504 Scholarship Updates



- Flat dollar award amount of \$5,000 annually
- All EPP candidates seeking initial licensure
- Remove HOPE eligibility
- Two-year teaching commitment
- Extend pilot program to 2030


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Generative artificial intelligence (GenAI) is changing the workforce rapidly; therefore, education must respond and evolve now to equip students with desirable skills for future careers.

- Reduce teacher tasks not related to teaching




### Nationally, K12 students, college undergraduates, and teachers are optimistic about Al's potential

I would prefer my teachers learn about new technologies like AI chatbots and incorporate them into lessons


All chatbots have the potential to help me grow as a teacher


If used to its highest potential, AI chatbots can help my students learn more and faster





### Research reveals a need for AI support





- Advantaged districts provide more Al teacher training; these teachers are more likely to be Al users
- District leaders see transformative potential for supporting the teacher workload and instructional quality
- Support for teachers and leaders is desired and needed to mitigate a third "digital divide"

Can you just tell me the answer?

It's important that you learn how to do this yourself! What do you think you need to do to multiply 2 by 5/12?

They need the same denominator.

That's a good thought, but in this case, you don't need to find a common denominator because you're multiplying, not adding or subtracting. What else could you try?

I want to check my students understanding at the end of class, do you have an exit ticket that I could use for this lesson?

Of course! An exit ticket is a great way to quickly assess your students' understanding at the end of the class. Here's a suggestion for an exit ticket related to HSA-SSE.A.1:

Provide your students with the following algebraic expression:

 $3x^2 - 5x + 2$ 

Ask them to complete the following tasks:


- 1. Identify the terms in the expression.
- 2. Identify the coefficients and the constant term.
- 3. Write an expression for the term with the highest degree.

This exit ticket will help you assess whether your students can recognize the different components of an algebraic expression and understand the concept of degree. You can collect their responses and review them to identify any misconceptions or areas where students may need additional support. Remember to keep the exit ticket brief and focused on the key concepts from the lesson. Good luck!







#### Principles for Wise Discovery



- Keep the human in the loop
- Learn with and about AI through literacy and training
- Research pilots and report learnings broadly
- Enable learning acceleration for all
- Keep gaps in access in mind
- Ensure safety, ethics, and security

GenAl capability will be best leveraged with the **creativity** that a teacher or student — the human — can apply to it. Effective use must be learned, modeled, and practiced.

Tennessee education must respond and evolve now to equip students with desirable skills for future careers.
