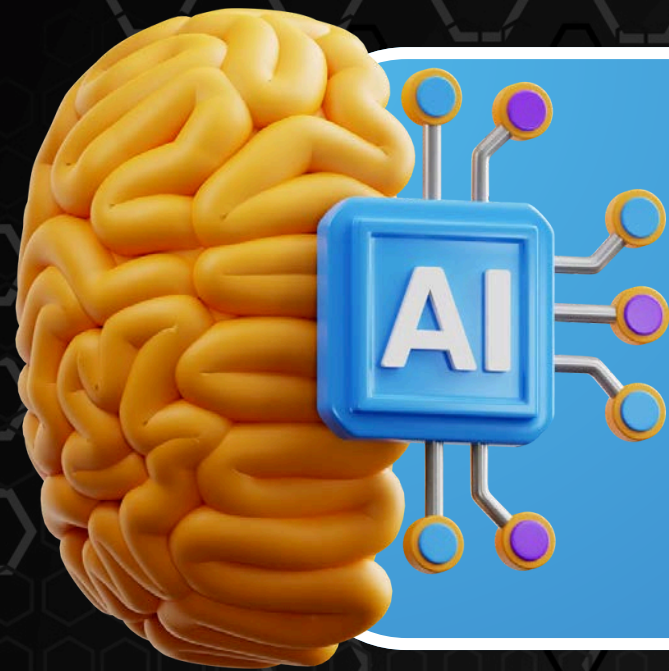

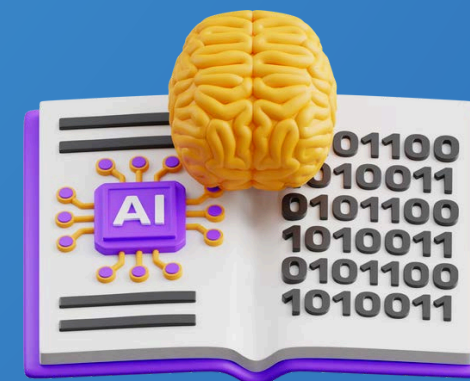
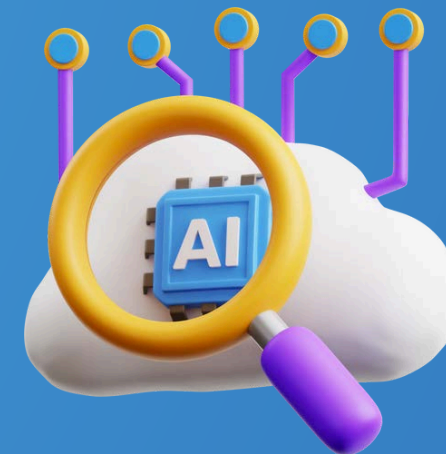
What is AI?

Robots Taking Over

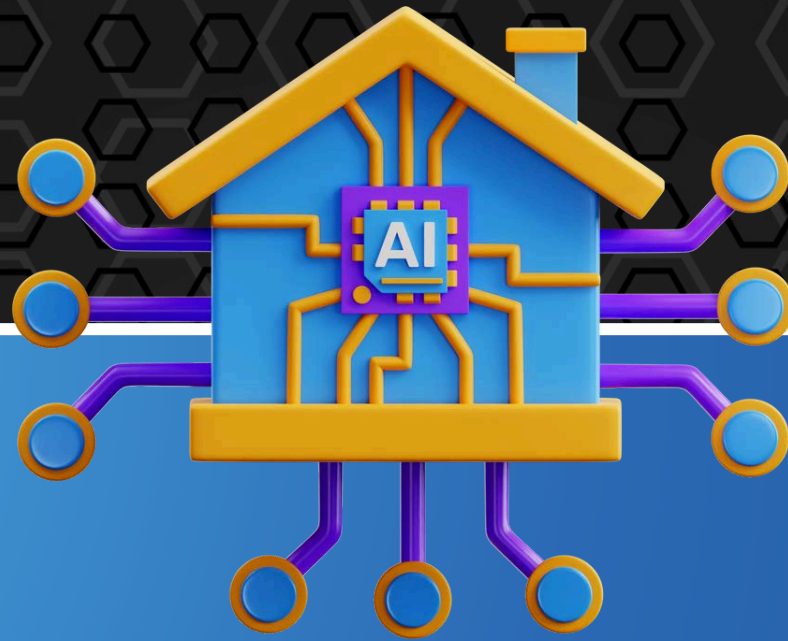
The robots are not taking over the world. They are helping to create opportunities for our all of us to be more efficient and have more access.

It is only as good as who is inputting the information. It is dependent on people.



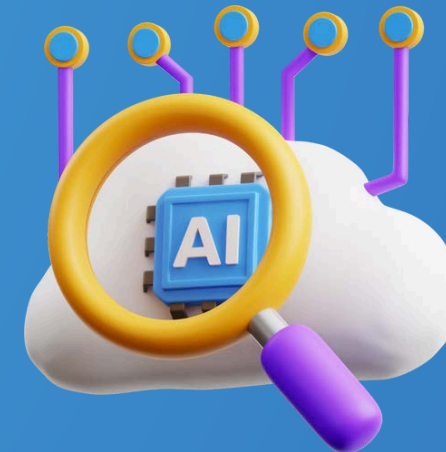
The Reason They Cheat

Pros and Cons

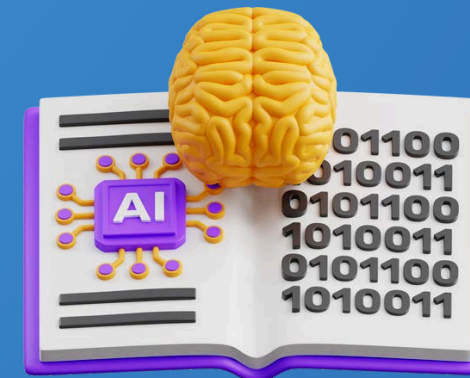
Pros

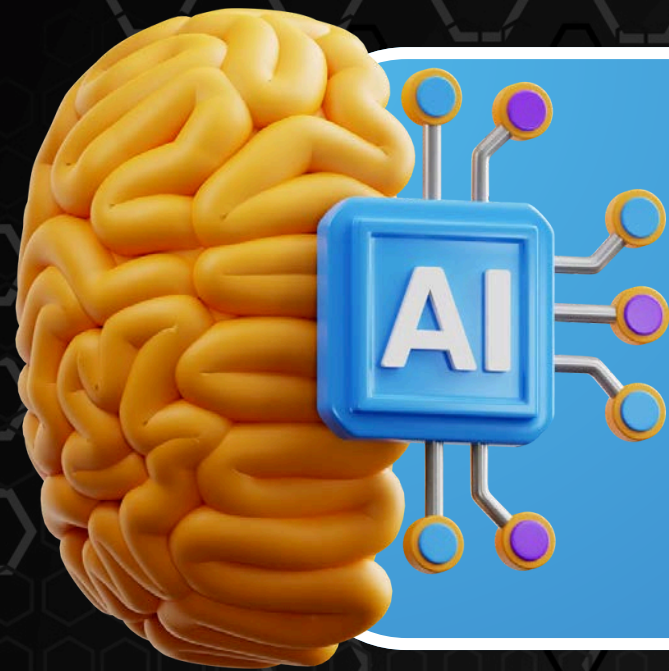
- Personalization of Learning
