

BACK TO STUDIO GUIDELINES



UFDA will be following CDC GUIDELINES and REQUIRES MASKS for ALL DANCERS 4yrs. & older AT THIS TIME

BEFORE COMING TO CLASS

- Take time to check that your child doesn't have any cold symptoms of runny nose, cough, fever, sore throat prior to coming to class.
- Student must stay home if he/she is not feeling well or anyone in the household has any Covid-19 symptoms listed above.
- Studio must be notified if child is out sick or absent for any reason. Please email contact@upperfallsdance.com

WHAT TO BRING TO DANCE

- Mask (extra mask recommended to keep in dance bag)
- Small dance bag and a yoga mat (**yoga mat for jazz, modern, lyrical & hip hop classes only**)
- Dancers must enter studio already dressed for class. Changing areas are limited.

ARRIVAL / DROP OFF

- Please reserve the parking spaces closest to the studio for parents of younger children to allow for easier drop off & pick up
- Arrive no earlier than 5 minutes before their scheduled class time.
- Students should wait outside patio (preferred) or in the studio kitchen until teacher allows students go to their assigned student waiting area.
- Parents may come inside to drop off and pick up their child.

INSIDE OF BUILDING

- **Masks must be worn** at all times for anyone 4 yrs. and older.
- Waiting area CLOSED for Parents. Parents may come in for drop off & pick up only. (Parents of children in Creative Movement & Intro. to Dance(ages 4-5) may stay).
- No food is allowed
- Students must sanitize hands upon entering and exiting the dance studio.

DISMISSAL / PICKUP

- Classes that end "on the hour or ½ hour" will finish a few minutes early.
- Parents are responsible for students being picked up on time.
- Parents of children under 10 must pick up their child either inside or on the outdoor patio.
- Students may wait inside the kitchen area between classes.

If a student has come in contact or has tested positive for Covid-19, they may not return to the studio until they have quarantined up to 10 days and cleared by a medical physician. No Virtual Classes are being offered at this time. Please talk to your child's teacher in regard to makeup classes. If the studio shuts down due to COVID-19, the schedule will move to virtual classes.
