Resilience In Times of Covid-19



With the objective of emotionally supporting & accompanying Mexico & Latin america's Health Care Personnel who have so bravely endured the pandemic throughout the last 2 years, we are continuing our program with Johnson & Johnson: "Resilience in Times of Covid-19".

WE EQUIP THE PARTICIPANTS WITH **ACTIVITIES SUCH AS:**

Workshops to learn about Resilience, emotional management & post-traumatic growth.

Emotional support video calls quided by a Dr. Payaso Coach & accompanied by a J&J volunteer.

Mass conferences to spread awareness on topics which facilitate resilience & emotional management in daily life.

During the almost 8 months of the Programs duration we directly impacted in 974,911 persons out of which 889,920 were patients and 84,991 was medical personnel working with them

We carried out 22 group workshops, 3 mass sessions, emailed 4,651 infographics with emotional tools & had our resilience and emotional skills video capsules virtually visited 5,948 times and together with J&J volunteers, we had 619 emotional support video calls with Health Care profesionals.

With our group workshops and massive sessions we were able to reach Health personnel from 18 countries, more than 500 health-related institutions throughout Latin America and more than 1,000 individual participants... it was incredible to have them all involved!

Our RESILIENCE IN TIMES OF COVID-19 program, was awarded in the "Special Category for Business Actions in the face of Covid-19", by Cemefi, Aliarse & "Business Forum" in Recognition of Best Corporate practices of Social Responsibility.
