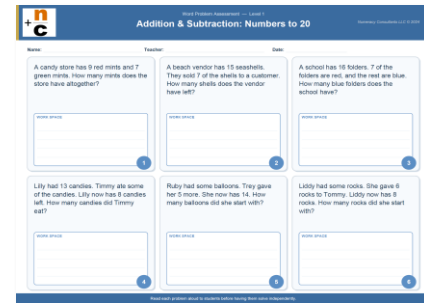


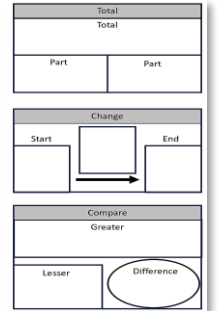
01 Administer the assessment

Identify where each student is struggling across word problem schema types.



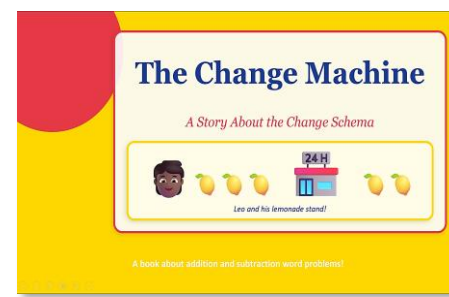
02 Choose a schema structure to teach

Use assessment results to select Part-Part-Total, Change, or Compare.



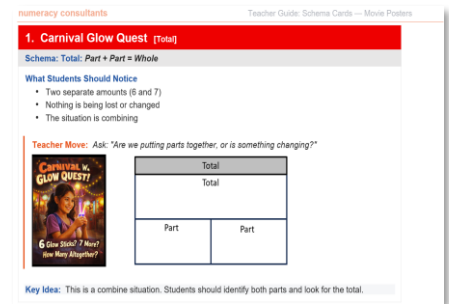
03 Read the read-aloud

Introduce the schema strategy through a shared reading experience.



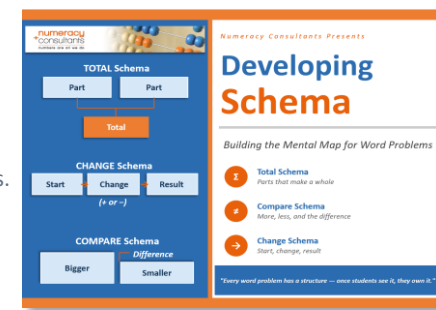
04 Use the schema posters

Build visual understanding of problem structure as a whole-group activity.



05 Use the developing schema resource

Start with numberless problems, then gradually introduce numbers and graphic organizers.



06 Find the schema in the workbook

Locate the chosen schema at the appropriate grade level and begin instruction
