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### THE COVENANTS

Whether you purchased your house 44 years ago or 44 days ago, you also bought into a true Homeowners' Association. We have common grounds, shady walkways, tennis and pickleball courts, a playground, and a wonderful pool. We also have covenants. These covenants help keep our neighborhood looking nice, thus making this a desirable neighborhood in which to live.

You should have a hard copy of the covenants. If not, you can download a PDF copy of the <u>covenants and by-laws</u> from the <u>Hvde Park Website</u>. You can also <u>contact a Board Member</u>, and we will get a hard copy to you.

PLEASE ABIDE BY THE COVENANTS. DID YOU KNOW...

### **Covenants Article V Section 4**

(n) **No advertising sign of any kind whatsoever** shall be erected upon or displayed or otherwise exposed to view on any lot or any improvement...

### **Covenants Article V Section 4**

(f)...Any and all equipment, coolers, **woodpiles**, **garbage cans**, refuse or storage piles placed on a lot... **shall be walled-in (screened) to conceal same from the view of neighboring lots, roads, streets, or open areas.** Plans... must be approved by the Committee prior to construction...Springfield City Ordinance 95.194 requires firewood to be placed **on open racks that are elevated not less than six inches above the ground**, and evenly piled or stacked...

### **Covenants Article V Section 4**

(o) No house trailer, boat, boat trailer, camper, tent, or any other such vehicle, trailer, vessel or temporary structure shall be permitted on any lot unless screened from view of adjoining lot, streets, and Common Areas...

### **Covenants Article V Section 1**

(a) **NO** construction, reconstruction, remodeling, alteration or addition to any structure, building, fence, wall, road, drive, path or improvement of any nature shall be constructed **without obtaining the prior written approval of** the Committee as to location, plans and specifications...

### **Covenants Article VI Section 1**

The easement area of each Lot and all improvements in it shall be maintained continuously by the Owner. (If your property line is less than 12 feet from the sidewalk in the common area, you are responsible for mowing and removing debris from your property line to the sidewalk. If you have a fence, you are still responsible for the area between yourfence and the sidewalk.)
