# POOL NEWS

We are all in this together. As we continue to face an unprecedented public health and safety threat, know that the Hyde Park Board will follow the advice of our state and local health officials. When the officials indicate it is safe to once again gather together, we will proceed with opening the pool. Additional lounge chairs, tables, and chairs have been purchased. Professionals have been hired to prepare the pool and the pool house for opening and repair and paint the interior of the pool house, including the floor and metal doors and trim. We will need homeowners' help in moving all the pool furniture out of the pool house, cleaning the pool house, deck and furniture and installing the pool stairs and basketball hoop. When we are able to proceed, we will let homeowners know the planned dates for these activities and the planned date for opening the pool.

CITY-WIDE BRANCH PICK-UP The city's spring branch pick-up starts the week of May 4. Each neighborhood will receive one (1) pick-up. The spring pick-up schedule is pre-set and crews will work in specified areas of the city each week. Crews will pass through an area only once.

As a reminder, the city's branch pick-up is a different program from the city's yard waste pick-up program. The branch pick-up program only occurs twice a year.

### Following is the spring branch pick-up schedule:

- Southeast area - branches set out by 7:00am the morning of May 18

Residents may drop off branches to Evans Recycling with proof of residency for free until March 2021. This service is for city residents only and not for commercial contractors. Evans Recycling is located at 2100 J. David Jones Parkway and is open Monday-Friday, 7:00am-5:00pm and Saturday, 7:00am-12n0on.

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR BRANCHES** The City of Springfield will pick up branch piles from residents:

- No larger than 3 feet in height, 4 feet in depth, and 10 feet in length
- Piles larger than a small pickup load will not be picked up by the city
- The program is for branches only, no logs will be accepted
- Branches/limbs trimmed by a commercial contractor will not be picked up
- Branches must be placed on the curb not obstructing the street or sidewalk
- Small branches may be broken up and put into yard waste bags and placed on the curb.
- Branches are not allowed on boulevards.
