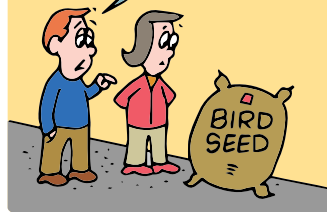
Why did the turtle cross the road?

The other one replies, "I want to go to Italy again, like last year."

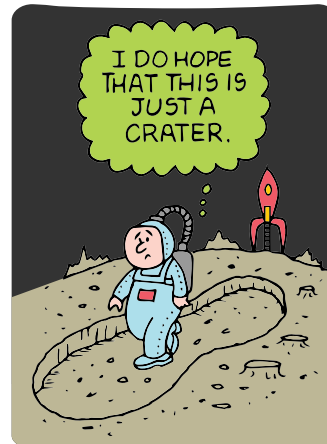
The first asks, "Wow! You went to Italy last year?"
