

MONTHLY RATE SCHEDULE

The water base rate will be increased as set forth on the following table beginning on JUNE 1ST 2019, and will increase annually subsequent to the initial increase. Any subsequent rate adjustments that increase rates will be subject to a Proposition 218 hearing.

I would like to explain the proposed rate increase structure. Instead of raising the rates immediately we want to slowly raise the rates over a period of five years. This will allow our customers to plan for the increases in advance. Our current rates are as follows; the base rate without water is \$30 a month. The water usage charge is 3 cents for every 7.48 gallons of water used. Any water usage over 14,960 gallons is charged 5 cents for every 7.48 gallons used.

The new proposed residential rates are as follows; the base rate will increase slightly once a year every year for five years. The first increase will be \$4.50 per month base rate. The water usage charge will go from 3 cents per 7.48 gallons to 4 cents per 7.48 gallons. There will not be an increase to the water usage for water used over 14,960 gallons. The new rate will stay at 4 cents for every 7.48 gallons no matter how much water is used. The second year the base rate will go up \$1.38. The third year the base rate will go up \$1.44. The fourth year the base rate will go up \$1.49 and the fifth and final year of increases the base rate will go up \$1.55 for a final base rate of \$40.36. In the five years of proposed increases the base rate will go from \$30 to \$40.36.
