DAY 1

FROM DARK TO LIGHT

- **Isaiah 43:19:** "See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it?" NLT

Oh that lovely Spring Forward time of year. We're in March and it's already arrived! The time has sprung forward but have you? Are you allowing yourself to spring into the new things God has for you? Or you sitting around waiting for another sign? Now is the time to spring forward in life. It's time to rise up from the earth and break through that soil you've been planted in throughout the winter.

There is a process called Germination that happens in gardening. It is when a seed becomes a plant. The seed goes through a very thorough process of growth. It's not easy and its pretty ugly. It's in the dark, under dirt, and it has to grow to move itself into the light. All of this requires patience, the right hydration, good healthy environment and the seed cannot depend on itself. It must be cultivated and watered. If we compare ourselves to the seed, we would say that the seed is in a place of humility. - **Colossians 2:7:** *"Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him. Then your faith will grow strong in the truth you were taught, and you will overflow with thankfulness." NLT*

When we're planted in the messiness of life, our roots determine the harvest that will rise up. Or are you going to tell God what to do and let your roots wither in the wrong direction? I ask a lot of questions because I want you to be able to reflect and gain a self awareness of your own personal life. Can you be planted and rooted so you can spring up in due time? It's going to require authentic patience, you're going to have to be in a waiting period. Be planted, rooted, and then get ready to rise up!

● **Isaiah 60:1:** *"Rise up, shine, for your light has come! The glory of the Lord has risen upon you". NLT*
