## SCHOOL BUS DERBY RULES

- (1) Any "C" type bus can be used for our school bus derby. The side of the bus(not including the driver side window) No snub nose bus or propane fueled buses will be able to run.**
- 2) All glass, lights, chrome trim, stop signs, placards ect must be removed. All passenger seats must be removed. Fire walls must remain in place. Nothing can be left in the bus must be cleaned out completely ex: broken glass. Windshield must be removed and all mirrors inside and out must be removed. You must place some type of screen in the driver's window opening.**
- 3) Remove all wheel weights inside and out of tire, a maximum of 10 gallons of fuel will be allowed, at time of inspection if more than 10 gallons is in the tank you will not be able to run.**
- 4) No more than (2) 1400 cold cranking amp batteries will be allowed. You may weld bumpers onto the frame if necessary. Must cut a 18x20 inch hole in the hood. All metal fan blades must be removed. The only exception is if it is equipped with a slip clutch. Must cover with fan shroud.**
- 5) Seatbelts and helmets must be dot approved, impact resistant eye protection, and neck brace are required. Additional safety regulations may be imposed due to track conditions. Any questions or concerns please call Donny 443-309-9065**
