We are the SaveBothell group that helped organize the first community meeting informing us about the NorthPoint development plans.

We are also the group who got out about 500 flyers informing neighbors of that meeting, and are behind the current drive collecting of neighbor's signatures on the letter to the county about the NorthPoint development.

We are planning another community meeting of the neighbors only, no NorthPoint or politicians this time, so that I can give the community updates as to what we have been doing, where we are in the process presently, and where we are going with the plans.

Kenmore Shooting Range 1031 228th St SW (formerly known as the Kenmore Gun Range) is the same location as the last meeting,  
Sept. 19, Monday evening, 7-9 pm.

Please bring chairs as the range only has 100 available, and we anticipate about the same size crowd of 300 as the last meeting.

This is our turn to inform you the neighbors of the facts, not to market an apartment complex to you as happened in the last meeting.

Our only recourse IF the county chooses to not listen to us, and grants NorthPoint a permit to build, is for us to hire legal assistance.

That is costly, so we are also fundraising at the meeting, so please bring your checkbook, as we are not set up to take credit cards at this time.

Hopefully, we will also have legal representation to speak at the meeting to answer questions about that side of the process.
