PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- No Site Council Meeting to report on.
- Enrollment is good. Largest school in district @ ~1780 students. Currently a wait list for open enrollment students.
- Half of Freshman Class is open enrolled.
- New Hall Pass System: students will need to scan in and out of each location. There is
 also a new color-coded system for the bathrooms. Hoping to reduce vandalism issues
 so that bathrooms don't need to be closed, and in the event of a fire drill or emergency
 students outside of classrooms will be able to be easily found because of the location
 scanning. Helps to improve overall campus safety.
- New attendance policy is in effect. 10 Unexcused absences within a class period will result in not receiving credit for the course. Appeals process in place to reverse no credits with a grade. Parent notices being sent out at 5, 7, & 9 unexcused absences.
- New AZ Cell Phone policy has been going better than expected. Students are being respectful when asked to put their device away during passing periods, and Principal Bulleigh is seeing more students talking with each other on campus versus being on their phones.

BUDGET/TREASURERS REPORT

- Current Balances: \$28,041.36 (Wells Fargo as of 6/30/2025) AND \$4,887.40 (PayPal as of 6/30/2025) = \$35,080.91 in total between both accounts.
- \$6000 in Spirit Wear Sales = 41% profit. Includes clearance sales at Cross Promotion and Freshman Bridge Program; however, currently upside down with Spirit Wear purchases.
- SY 25/26 Budget was finalized with some reorganization for some categories to cover recurrent requests and for better planning.
- \$25,000 in expenses with a goal of \$28,000 in Spirit Wear Sales.
- \$1807 Marquee Donation balance being held at this time.

OLD BUSINESS

- Registration/Spirit Wear Sales
 - o 100 items sold out of inventory during Freshman Bridge Program; unsure if it affected registration sales.
 - o Registration was located at new location. Sales totaled around \$10,000 for both online and in-person. Online ordering increased with 16 orders made.
 - o Christina is working on getting Senior Shirts created with vendor.
- Staff Welcome Lunch
 - o Thank you to everyone who helped. The event was a huge success.
 - o Catered by La Hacienda. Cost for meal was \$2400; PTO charged \$800.
- Newsletter/Social Media Platforms
 - Facebook @ 1.1K Followers; Instagram @ 100 Followers which is great since it hasn't been promoted yet. Vilma is planning to start the promoting process next week for Instagram.
 - Weekly newsletters have been going well. More of a story like format versus repeated information. Scheduled posts have been helpful in managing the multiple accounts.
 - Principal Bulleigh to get Vilma access to Student Square to be able to access postings to share on various platforms.

NEW BUSINESS

- Staff Wishlist/Paper Goods Drive
 - Lots of teacher requests for Kleenex. Other requests will be reviewed with Principal Bulleigh to determine what she is able to fulfill before PTO assesses what to fulfill by next PTO meeting. Goal is to get requests delivered sometime in September.
 - o 3rd Annual Paper Goods Drive: 8-9am on 8/22 & 8/29 at both lots. Focusing on Kleenex, Hand Sanitizer, and Clorox Wipes. Open House 8/27 will have a drop off box and parents can drop off donations year-round in the front office.
- Open House
 - Wednesday 8/27; Spirit Wear table set up @ 4pm. Please come to help if you are able; you will still be able to see your students' teachers etc.
