- ❖ 6th Grade Class Committee: Parent Planning Committee (PPC) for end of the year celebrations for our graduating 6th graders.
 - Jamie Oatley will lead PPC
 - o Previous 6th grade class shut down 501c3 and insurance.
 - Proposal was made for a sub-committee with the PTG in order to have a current bank account for 6th grade events and funds.
 - Funds will always have a separate bank account for PPC (subaccount under PTG bank account).
 - PPC will be their own entity and not governed by the PTG, thus PTG will have no say or control over PPC or their associated decision made.
 - Justification of Need: Being covered under PTG insurance would allow all events for 6th grade to be covered under this insurance. 6th Grade events are few and the process of getting individual 501c3 and insurance would be too costly and lengthy of a process. This saves money in the future years for 6th grade events.
