Tuesday, March 28, 2000 at 6:00 AM, I received a phone call at my residence from Sgt. Det Creavin requesting that I report to duty as soon as possible. When I arrived to Area D-14, I responded to 89 Faneuil Street, where I joined a homicide investigation being conducted by Sergeant Detective Daniel Coleman of the Homicide Unit. I was directed by Sgt. Det Thomas Creavin to the roof of 89 Faneuil St and the adjacent buildings to search for any evidence or weapons relating to the investigation. After searching the area and finding no evidence or weapons I returned to Area D-14 to document my actions.

Some time after 12 noon myself and Sgt. Det Creavin went to the Watertown Police Dept. where we met a Det. Joe Kelly who accompanied us to 8 Hearn St. Watertown the address of the deceased Inaam Yazbek. At that location we were met by [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]) who is a cousin and roommate to the deceased. [REDACTED] stated that he went out with a friend last and last saw his cousin at 9:00PM at 8 Hearn St. He further stated that Inaam's brother [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]) also lived at 8 Hearn St. along with a very close family friend [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED], sst# [REDACTED]).

[REDACTED] contacted [REDACTED] by telephone and asked him to meet us at 8 Hearn St. When [REDACTED] arrived, he stated that the brother [REDACTED] does not speak english and would help us in telling the brother that his brother is deceased. [REDACTED] stated that he is a very close friend of the family and that he had just returned from Lebanon where he and the victim grew up together. [REDACTED] stated that he last saw Inaam at about 10:30 PM on 03/27/00 when he left the apartment and stated he would be back in a couple of hours. [REDACTED] also informed me that Inaam had received a phone call prior to leaving. [REDACTED] also stated that Inaam had been hanging around with some young girls recently and that several of them have been to 8 Hearn St. He only knew some of the first names of the females, the names he gave me were [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and the other name he could not remember. The females were described as being white and about 17 to 18 years of age, he described two of the females as being Russian and one being Italian and the other Irish. He told me that the girls were into drugs and alcohol. He then told myself and Sgt. Creavin that we should talk with [REDACTED] who is a cousin and good friend of the deceased and that he was the one who had introduced Inaam to several of the girls. [REDACTED] also told me that Inaam had money with when he left the house and he estimated that it was about one thousand dollars.

At about 3:00 PM myself and Sgt. Creavin met [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (W/M/S, DOB [REDACTED], Tel# [REDACTED]) at Area D-14 in Brighton. We then transported both individuals to the Homicide Unit at Boston Police Headquarters to be interviewed. Sgt. Det Creavin conducted a taped interview of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], after the interview the tapes were left for Sgt. Det Daniel Coleman and we the transported [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] back to Area D-14. He said that [REDACTED] was from [REDACTED] and that [REDACTED] was from [REDACTED]. He said that [REDACTED] was the friendliest towards Inaam. He told that until recently most of the females he had named lived at [REDACTED] which is located behind [REDACTED] home at [REDACTED].

He did tell me that a ring that he always wears was not with the other items. He described the ring as black and gold colored Masonic ring that had the Mason's symbol on it.

On 03/30/00 at about 11:30 Am I received a phone call from [REDACTED] who stated that he was with [REDACTED] owner of the Wade Restaurant, 96 School Street, Watertown, and the owner told him that Inaam was in the restaurant with a young white female at about 11:30 PM on 03/27/00. I then requested that [REDACTED] along with her husband [REDACTED], who also owns the restaurant if they could come to the Homicide Unit to be interviewed. Myself and Sgt. Det Creavin transported Mr. & Mrs [REDACTED] to Boston Police Headquarters to be interviewed by Sgt. Det Coleman.

[REDACTED] stated to me that on the night of 03/29/00 [REDACTED] received several calls from [REDACTED] inquiring about the victim and also what the police were doing. [REDACTED] has caller ID, and the number from where [REDACTED] called was [REDACTED].

Daniel Coleman at a homicide crime scene. Officers entered the crime scene at approximately 5:18 A.M. and were assigned to conduct interviews of the neighborhood residents by Sgt. Det. Daniel Coleman. The following is a list of persons interviewed and the information they provided.

Interviews conducted at 89 Fanieul St. Brighton:

At 5:20A.M. APT. 250. Thong Dam, 02/04/76, 783-1884 witness went to sleep at 11:35P.M. Witness heard one loud bang at approximately 12:00A.M. He thought it was gunfire. Just prior to that he heard a female say "Do you have a lighter?" A male answered but he could not hear the answer.

[REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] This witness also heard one loud bang between 11:00P.M. -12:00A.M. but did not hear any conversation.

(one wearing a blue jacket, the other a light blue T-shirt) The two males continued to argue while the witness fell asleep. She awoke to the sound of a loud bang, sounded like thunder. [REDACTED] stated that an unknown person whistling is what originally caused her to look out the window.

[REDACTED]. 10-29-66. About 1:25 A.M. claims while sitting in the living room she heard a loud bang, prior to that she saw and heard nothing.



The following is the substance of statements made by either [REDACTED] and or [REDACTED] to [REDACTED]:

About a week or more before the break-in in New Hampshire [REDACTED] had the following conversation with [REDACTED]. The conversation took place in Newton in [REDACTED]'s car. They were the only two in the car. [REDACTED] discussed the group he wanted to organize. He mentioned how girls could have a role in the group because girls could be good bait. She mentioned that her father had guns in North Conway, New Hampshire. He mentioned how guns could worth a lot of money.

After checking in at the Yankee Clipper in New Hampshire [REDACTED] stated to [REDACTED] that he made a mistake by signing his own name in the hotel register.

On the way back to Boston from New Hampshire Anderson spoke about the group he wanted to organize. He also told her about earlier incidents he had been involved in such as locking someone in a trunk and kidnapping them. He said if anyone asked him whether he had gone to New Hampshire he would say he went to visit a relative in Manchester. He also mentioned he could get a lot of money for the gun and spoke about meeting with someone in Rhode Island or Connecticut.

In the car ride from the Development to her house [REDACTED] recalled [REDACTED] indicated he would have his pager. When the conversation came up about where the robbery should take place, [REDACTED] stated to [REDACTED] this is your area. You figure it out. When the place was agreed upon Robinson stated to [REDACTED] that she should bring the victim into the hallway. During the ride [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] if she was sure the victim would have a lot of money.

After the shooting and at some point during the ride [REDACTED] suggested going by the Development.

After meeting [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] in the park [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that prints in the car will come back to her. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] should tell the police if questioned that the victim dropped her off at the Development and she didn't see him again. He said everything was fine. The police have no witnesses and no weapon. [REDACTED] said to [REDACTED] you'll be straight; stick to the story.

On the ride to the Arsenal Mall when [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] she didn't intend to go back to her house, [REDACTED] told her to stick around and play it out. When she told him their whole lives have changed he said he knows. He then proceeds to tell her if she is questioned by police she knows what to say. Again he reminds her of the story she should give. She should state that she went out with victim but didn't see him after he dropped her off. He reiterated that the police have no witnesses and no weapon. [REDACTED] said she should say if questioned that she does not know him. The police have no connection between the two of them. Some time that evening she again spoke with [REDACTED]. He mentioned his brother was flying in that weekend and that he had to pick his brother up and go to his birthday party. He said he would pick her up and take her to the party. She never heard from him again.

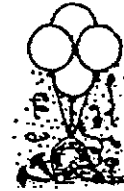

# Form W-4 (1997)

## Want More Money In Your Paycheck?

If you expect to be able to take the earned income credit for 1997, and a child lives with you, you may be able to have part of the credit added to your take home pay. For details, get Form W-5 from your employer.

**Purpose.** Complete Form W-4 so that your employer can withhold the correct amount of Federal income tax from your pay. Form W-4 may be completed electronically, if your employer has an electronic system. Because your tax situation may change, you may want to refigure your withholding each year.

**Exemption From Withholding.** Read line 7 of the certificate below to see if you can claim exempt status. If exempt, only complete lines 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, and sign the form to validate it. No Federal income tax will be withheld from your pay. Your exemption expires February 17, 1998.

**Note:** You cannot claim exemption from withholding if (1) your income exceeds \$950 and includes unearned income (e.g., interest and dividends) and (2) another person can claim you as a dependent on their tax return.

**Basic Instructions.** If you are not exempt, complete the Personal Allowances Worksheet. Additional worksheets are on page 2 so you can adjust your withholding allowances based on itemized deductions, adjustments to income, or two-earner/two-job situations. Complete all worksheets that apply to your situation. The worksheets will help you figure the number of withholding allowances you are entitled to claim. However, you may claim fewer allowances than this.

**Head of Household.** Generally, you may claim head of household filing status on your tax return only if you are unmarried and pay more than 50% of the costs of keeping up a home for yourself and your dependent(s) or other qualifying individuals.

**Nonwage Income.** If you have a large amount of nonwage income, such as interest or dividends, you should consider making

estimated tax payments using Form 1040-ES. Otherwise, you may find that you owe additional tax at the end of the year.

**Two Earners/Two Jobs.** If you have a working spouse or more than one job, figure the total number of allowances you are entitled to claim on all jobs using worksheets from only one W-4. This total should be divided among all jobs. Your withholding will usually be most accurate when all allowances are claimed on the W-4 filed for the highest paying job and zero allowances are claimed for the others.

**Check Your Withholding.** After your W-4 takes effect, use Pub. 918, Is My Withholding Correct for 1997, to see how the dollar amount you are having withheld compares to your estimated total annual tax. Get Pub. 918 especially if you used the Two-Earner/Two-Job Worksheet and your earnings exceed \$150,000 (Single) or \$200,000 (Married). To order Pub. 919, call 1-800-829-3676. Check your telephone directory for the IRS assistance number for further help.

**Sign This Form.** Form W-4 is not considered valid unless you sign it.
