The Asian Game of Mahjong, Which Creates Order Out of Chaos, Is Trending in the West

This 200-year-old tile game is popping up in clubs, hotels and parties as a way for Gen Zers and millennials to connect.

Mahjong (麻将) is a traditional Chinese game that has deep roots in Chinese culture and dates back to the Qing Dynasty (around the mid-19th century). The game likely evolved from various Chinese card games and was originally played with tiles. The game gained immense popularity in China and, over time, spread to other parts of Asia and the Western world.

In the 1920s, Mahjong made its way to the United States, where it was adapted into what we now call "American Mahjong." American Mahjong uses a "Mahjong card," which has a list of legal hands for the year. Each hand requires specific sets and combinations, making it more structured than some other Mahjong variants. You'll need to learn this card, as it dictates the types of hands that can win in each round.

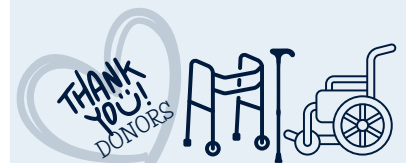

Unbiased reporting of events deemed important to LCCA members

Summer is finally upon us, bringing all the beauty and enjoyment that Lagoon City has to offer. After a long wait for water levels to recede, boat traffic is quickly increasing. Please be vigilant and courteous when enjoying our waterways.

Our local wildlife also seems to be more visible than in recent years. Bear sightings have increased, coywolves have been spotted, and even a moose has wandered into the area. Beavers, foxes, raccoons, skunks, and turtles remain common throughout the community. Please use caution when walking trails or travelling at night, and be mindful of small pets.

Council Highlights

- Council directed staff to begin the process of stopping up, closing, and **conveying Concord Woods Court** as part of a long-standing subdivision proposal. Personally, I wouldn't get too excited just yet, I usually wait until I see shovels in the ground.
- Council received a report regarding the **installation of monitoring panels** in municipal buildings and approved a budget amendment of \$20,680 from the Capital Reserve for Phase One of the project. Phase Two has been referred to the 2027 budget process. The anticipated payback period is estimated at one to two years.
- Council confirmed the appointment of **Councillor David Snutch** to the Executive Committee of the Top Aggregate Producing Municipalities of Ontario (**TAPMO**) for the remainder of the 2024–2026 term.

Council Highlights Continued

- Council reviewed the **City of Orillia's request for recreation funding** and acknowledged the value and quality of recreational services available to Ramara residents. Council directed staff from both municipalities to develop a six-month data collection program to better understand resident usage of Orillia facilities and programs. Township staff were also directed to undertake community engagement to determine resident support for potential Township contributions to offset non-resident user fees.
- Council directed staff to prepare a report on the feasibility of installing **"Children at Play" signage** on Sideroad 5 between Concession Road 1 and Concession Road 2, including identifying potential locations.
- Council received the **Township's 2025 Consolidated Financial Statements**. The statements show a positive overall financial position, including increases in net financial assets and accumulated surplus. While the Township's financial position has improved, the report also notes the need to continue identifying additional revenue sources to meet current obligations and support long-term financial sustainability.

Changes to Ontario Auto Insurance

- Beginning July 1, 2026, Ontario's auto insurance system will allow consumers to opt out of several accident benefit protections that were previously included automatically in many policies.
- These changes may affect coverage related to income replacement, caregiving, housekeeping assistance, dependant care, rehabilitation, and other accident benefit supports.
- For older Canadians in particular, these benefits can become critically important following an accident. Many consumers may not fully understand the implications of the choices presented to them at renewal time. You may wish to review your policy carefully when it comes up for renewal after July 1.

Canal Weed Management Update

- The Township has provided the following update regarding aquatic weed management:
- "As part of an internal review of operational practices, Township staff have been working with the Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR) and the Department of Fisheries and Oceans (DFO) to ensure aquatic weed management activities continue to support navigable waterways while protecting fish habitat and the broader aquatic ecosystem."
- The Township recently received confirmation that approvals from the DFO are required for aquatic weed skimming and harvesting activities moving forward. Staff are working proactively with the DFO to better understand how these requirements apply to Lagoon City's unique waterway system and to complete the necessary approval process. Mechanical aquatic weed management is anticipated to begin in the coming weeks.
