Located in beautiful Highland Park (Rochester's first public park, designed by Frederick Law Olmsted), the Conservatory is a serene and colorful glass greenhouse featuring a diverse collection of plants and water features, including special spring bulb flower displays.
- 11:15 At the end of your tour, reboard your motorcoach and transfer to lunch.
- Enjoy a served lunch with your group at Pane Vino on the Avenue (3400 Monroe Ave, Rochester). Please choose one of the following entrees when you register: Penne Bolognese (beef, pork, & veal in marinara sauce with herb ricotta) OR Chicken French (over spinach & linguine) OR Shaved Prime Rib Sandwich (with peppers and onions, provolone cheese, a side of au jus, shoestring fries & pickle). Your meal will also include soup, rolls & butter, assorted cookies for dessert, and coffee/tea & soda.
- 1:00 pm After lunch transfer to the Geva Theatre (75 Woodbury Blvd, Rochester) and be seated.
- 2:00 Enjoy a performance of "BAREFOOT IN THE PARK" (center orchestra seating)
- 4:30 At the end of the show (estimated), reboard your coach and depart on the return trip home.
