- ◆ Deluxe chartered motorcoach transportation from Niagara Scenic Coach Lines; accommodations for three nights in Nashville and two nights en route in Cincinnati, Ohio and Louisville, Kentucky.
- ◆ Orchestra seats for "Celebrate Opry 100" at the Grand Ole Opry. Celebrate the 100th year of this iconic institution with superstars, newcomers and legends - it's never the same show twice. You're invited to the show that made country music famous as we highlight country music's past, present and future! (the lineup of performers will be announced a few months/weeks before the show date).

- ◆ Backstage Tours of the Grand Ole Opry & Ryman Auditorium (the historic former home of the Grand Ole Opry). You will relive unforgettable Opry moments and hear behind-the-scenes stories of the stars who shaped the Opry's legacy, as you go backstage to explore artist-only rooms with exclusive photos and memorabilia.
- ◆ Guided tour of Nashville, including the Music City's most iconic landmarks; followed by a self-guided visit to the Country Music Hall of Fame, and a guided tour of historic RCA Studio B, Nashville's Temple of Sound, where Elvis Presley, Dolly Parton and Waylon Jennings recorded hits.
- ◆ Guided tour of Louisville, KY, a historic city of southern charm with a booming bourbon renaissance. Your visit will include the Kentucky Derby Museum, where you will view the film "The Greatest Race" and have a walking tour of Churchill Downs race track. Also you will have a guided tour of the Louisville Slugger Museum & Factory, where you will explore the history of an American icon that has been making bats since 1884!
- ◆ Stop en route in Bowling Green, KY for a guided tour of the National Corvette Museum, where the legacy and history of America's sports car comes to life.
