John Chapter 13 Jesus Answers 6 Question from 5 of 12 Disciples (13-14) at the Upper Room

1-5 ***The Master Washes the Servants Feet (including Judas Iscariot)***

(68) ¹ Now before the feast of the passover, when Jesus knew that His hour was come that He should depart out of this world to the Father, having loved His own which were in the world, He loved them to the end. ² And supper being ended, the devil having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's [son], to betray Him; ³ Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He was come from God, and went to God; ⁴ He rises from supper, and laid aside His garments; and took a towel, and girded Himself. ⁵ After that He pours water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel wherewith He was girded.

6-22 Q1: ***Peter Asks Jesus about Washing his Feet (betrayal announced)***

(69) ⁶ Then comes He to Simon Peter: and Peter says unto Him, Lord, do you wash my feet? ⁷ Jesus answered and said unto him, What I do you know not now; but you shall know hereafter. ⁸ Peter says unto Him, You shall never wash my feet. Jesus answered Him, If I wash you not, you have no part with Me. ⁹ Simon Peter says unto him, Lord, not my feet only, but also [my] hands and [my] head. ¹⁰ Jesus says unto him, He that is washed needs not save to wash [his] feet, but is clean every whit: and ye are clean, but not all. ¹¹ For He knew who should betray Him; therefore said He, Ye are not all clean. ¹² So after He had washed their feet, and had taken His garments, and was set down again, He said unto them, Know ye what I have done unto you? ¹³ Ye call Me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for [so] I am. ¹⁴ If I then, [your] Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet. ¹⁵ For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done unto you. ¹⁶ Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Servant is not greater than His lord; neither He that is sent greater than He that sent Him. ¹⁷ If ye know these things, happy are ye if ye do them. ¹⁸ I speak not of you all: I know whom I have chosen: but that the Scripture may be fulfilled, He that eats bread with Me has lifted up his heel against Me. ¹⁹ Now I tell you before it come, that, when it is come to pass, ye may believe that I AM. ²⁰ Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that receives whomsoever I send receives Me; and he that receives Me receives Him that sent Me. ²¹ When Jesus had thus said, He was troubled in spirit, and testified, and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, that one of you shall betray Me. ²² Then the disciples looked one on another, doubting of whom He spoke.

23-30 Q2: ***John Asks Jesus who Will Betray Him (Judas Iscariot departs)***

(70) ²³ Now there was leaning on Jesus' bosom one of His disciples, whom Jesus loved. ²⁴ Simon Peter therefore beckoned to him, that he should ask who it should be of whom He spoke. ²⁵ He then lying on Jesus' breast says unto Him, Lord, who is it? ²⁶ Jesus answered, He it is, to whom I shall give a sop, when I have dipped [it]. And when He had dipped the sop, He gave [it] unto Judas Iscariot, [the son] of Simon. ²⁷ And after the sop Satan entered into him. Then said Jesus unto him, That you do, do quickly. ²⁸ Now no man at the table knew for what intent He spoke this unto him. ²⁹ For some [of them] thought, because Judas had the bag, that Jesus had said unto him, Buy [those things] that we have need of against the feast; or, that he should give something to the poor. ³⁰ He then having received the sop went immediately out: and it was night.

Note: The sop is a serving of bread, the tip goes with the bread. The host offering others bread with sop is an act of friendship and love.

31-35 **A New Commandment is Given – Love One Another**

(71) ³¹ Therefore, when he was gone out, Jesus said, Now is the Son of Man glorified, and God is glorified in Him. ³² If God be glorified in Him, God shall also glorify Him in Himself, and shall straightway glorify Him. ³³ Little children, yet a little while I am with you. Ye shall seek Me: and as I said unto the Jews, Where I go, ye cannot come; so now I say unto you. ³⁴ **A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.** ³⁵ **By this shall all [men] know that ye are My disciples, if ye have love one to another.**

Note: 1st of 10 commandments Jesus and reminded by John, the command us to love one another (5:12, 15:17, 1 John 3:11, 3:23, 4:7, 4:11, 4:12, 2 John 1:5).

36-14:4 Q3: **Peter Asks Jesus Where Are You Going?**

(72) ³⁶ Simon Peter said unto Him, Lord, where are you going? Jesus answered him, **Where I go, you cannot follow Me now; but you shall follow Me afterwards.** ³⁷ Peter said unto Him, Lord, why cannot I follow you now? I will lay down my life for your sake. ³⁸ Jesus answered him, Will you lay down your life for My sake? Verily, verily, I say unto you, The cock shall not crow, till you have denied Me thrice.

John Chapter 14

¹ **Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in Me.** ² **In My Father's house are many mansions:** if [it were] not [so], I would have told you. **I go to prepare a place for you.** ³ **And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto Myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.** ⁴ **And where I go ye know, and the way ye know.**

Note: Mansions - the mansions are in heaven and described in Revelation 21-22. This is our inheritance as children of God in the dispensation of the grace of God (Ephesians 3:2). The same word in Greek is used at John 14:23 by translated as "abode" due to context. See Isaiah 63:15, 2 Cor 5:1, Ps 11:4. Receive us as in 1-2 Thess, 1 Cor 15.

5-7 Q4: **Thomas Asks Jesus About How Can They Go With Jesus**

(73) ⁵ Thomas says unto Him, Lord, we know not where you go; and how can we know the way? ⁶ Jesus says unto him, **I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man comes to the Father, but by Me.** ⁷ If ye had known Me, ye should have known My Father also: and from henceforth ye know Him, and have seen Him.

Note: Christ is the sinner's Way to the Father and to heaven and to Way to live daily; not another way. The Truth is , the absolute trust that all that is written in the Bible is truth. The Life whose life-giving Spirit the dead in sin are quickened and the believers are sustained and empowered daily to follow Christ in his works. .

8-21 Q5: **Philip Asks Jesus to Show them the Father**

(74) ⁸ **Philip says unto Him, Lord, show us the Father, and it satisfies us.** ⁹ Jesus says unto him, I have been so long time with you, and yet have you not known Me, Philip? **he that has seen Me has seen the Father;** and how say you [then], Show us the Father? ¹⁰ **Believe you not that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of Myself: but the Father that dwells in Me, He does the works.** ¹¹ Believe Me that I [am] in the Father, and the Father in Me: or else believe Me for the very **works'** sake. ¹² Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believes on Me, the **works** that I do shall he do also; and greater **works** than these shall he do; because I go to My Father. ¹³ **And whatsoever ye shall ask in My name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.** ¹⁴ If ye shall ask anything in My name, I will do [it]. ¹⁵ If ye love Me, **keep My commandments.** ¹⁶ And I will pray the Father, and He shall give you **another Comforter,** that **He may abide with you forever;** ¹⁷ **[Even] the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it sees Him not, neither knows Him: but ye know Him; for He dwells with you, and shall be in you.** ¹⁸ I will not leave you an orphan: I will come unto you. ¹⁹ Yet a little while, and the world sees Me no more; but ye see Me: because I live, ye shall live also. ²⁰ **At that day ye shall know that I [am] in My Father, and ye in Me, and I in you.** ²¹ **He that has My commandments, and keeps them, he it is that loves Me: and he that loves Me shall be loved of My Father, and I will love him, and will manifest Myself to him.**

John Chapter 14

Q – What are the greater works that followers of Jesus Christ shall do? (14:12)

A – The greater works are not miracles, but the saved that “do and teach” as Jesus began to do in discipleship with those the Father gave him. (Acts 1:1). Greater works in Luke 10 when the 70 return.

Application: I must not apply the disciples of Jesus examples before they received the power of Christ in them through the gift of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost (Acts 2) because they were still under the Old Covenant. I will teach others this truth so they cannot justify personal sin using examples from the disciples of Jesus before they received the gift of the Holy Spirit.

22-31 Q6: **Judas Asks Why Jesus Shows Himself to the 11 Disciples and Not to the World**

(75) ^{22 a} Judas says unto Him, not Iscariot, Lord, what is the cause that you will show yourself to us, and not to the world? ²³ Jesus answered and said unto him, **If a man love Me, he will keep My words: and My Father will love him, and We will come unto him, and make Our abode with him.** ²⁴ He that **loves Me not keeps not My sayings: and the word which ye hear is not Mine, but the Father's which sent Me.** ²⁵ These things I have spoken unto you, being [yet] present with you. ²⁶ But the **Comforter, [which is] the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.**

(76) ²⁷ **Peace I leave with you, My peace I give unto you:** not as the world gives, give I unto you. **Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.** ²⁸ Ye have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come [again] unto you. If ye loved Me, ye would rejoice, because I said, I go to the Father: for **My Father is greater than I.** ²⁹ And now I have told you before it come to pass, that, when it is come to pass, ye might **believe.** ³⁰ Hereafter I will not talk much with you: for the **prince of this world comes, and has nothing in Me.** ³¹ But that the world may know that I love the Father; and as the Father gave Me commandment, even so I do. **Arise, let us go from here.**

^a Judas or Jude is the brother of James, who is mentioned in a list of apostles names in Mt 10:3, Mk 3:18, Lu 16:6, Acts 1:13, and only here does he speak. Judas is the 4th and last person to ask Jesus a question (Peter, Thomas, Phillip, and Judas). Judas discerned judgment coming, which leads toward understanding his writing the book of Jude. He is a cousin of Jesus Christ. Lastly, being the 4th to speak and with such depth, he a type of Elihu in the book of Job who spoke after the other three.

^b Jesus and the apostles now rose from the Passover supper and went to the Mount of Olives in chapters 15-16, while the prayer in chapter 17 was delivered on the way to the garden of Gethsemane.
