

The Mysteries of God Revealed in the New Testament (Deuteronomy 29:29, Daniel 2:22, Matthew 13:35)

Note 1: Convergence of: **26 mysteries revealed** - 3 by Jesus, 19 by Paul, 4 by John; and **32 parables revealed** by Jesus; and **12 "I AMs"** by John. The mysteries revealed are divided into 3 parts: the beginning of creation; today, in the churches; & at the end of the world, relating to Jesus's offices of prophet, priest, and king.

By Jesus - The parable of the sower, and the seed, and the 4 soils (Jesus is the present priest in heaven)

(Kingdom of heaven/kingdom of God on earth in Revelation 19-20 and from Heaven in Revelation 21-22)

- Mt 13:11** He answered and said unto them, Because it is **given unto you to know** the **mysteries** of the kingdom of heaven, **but to them it is not given.**
- Mr 4:11** And he said unto them, **Unto you it is given to know** the **mystery** of the kingdom of God: **but unto them that are without, all [these] things are done in parables:**
- Lu 8:10** And he said, **Unto you it is given to know** the **mysteries** of the kingdom of God: **but to others in parables; that seeing they might not see, and hearing they might not understand.**

Paul writes 19 mysteries (mysterion, G3466) for the church

By Paul: "my" gospel creational mystery. 4 mysteries by Paul, all of God. Zero parables. Zero "I AMs.

Note: Jesus is the New Testament, see John's 12 "I AMs" timeline, and 1 John 2:13-14, 3:8.

- Ro 16:25** Now to Him /God/ that is of **power /dunamis/ to establish /Romans 2:16/ you** according to **my gospel**, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the **revelation of the mystery**, which was **kept secret since the world began /God/ 2 Corinthians 12:1-10, 2 Peter 3:15-16/**
- 1Co 2:7** But **we** speak the **wisdom** of God in a **mystery**, [even] the **hidden** [wisdom], which God ordained **before the world** unto our glory: /God/
- Eph 3:9** And to make all [men] see what [is] the **fellowship of the mystery**, which **from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God**, who created all things by Jesus Christ: /God/ John 1:1-3/
- Col 1:26** [Even] the **mystery** which hath been **hid** from ages and from generations, /Beginning/ but now is made manifest to His saints: /God/Colossians 1:24-28/

By Paul: "my" gospel church(es) mysteries. 12 mysteries by Paul, and 1 mystery by John, and 1 John 1:1, 2:7, 2:24, 3:11. 21 parables. 5 "I AMs" by John for Jesus' present role as priest for the church(es) in John 10-17.

- 1Co 4:1** Let a man so account of **us**, as of the **ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God.** /God, ordained elders/
- 1Co 13:2** And though I have [the gift of] prophecy, and **understand all mysteries**, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, **I am nothing.**
1Co 14:2 For he that speaketh in an [unknown] tongue /known foreign language, unknown to the hearers/ speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth [him]; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh **mysteries.**
- Eph 1:9** Having made **known** unto **us** the **mystery** of His will, according to His good pleasure which He hath purposed in Himself: /God/Ephesians 1:10-23/Ephesians 1:18 and Hebrews 6:4 (6:4-8)/
- Eph 3:3** How that **by revelation He /Jesus/ made known unto me** the **mystery**; (as I wrote afore in few words, /when? Galatians 1:11-12,15-19, 2 Corinthians 12:1-10/Jesus/Ephesians 3:3-9/
- Eph 3:4** Whereby, when ye read, ye may **understand my knowledge** in the **mystery** of Christ) /Christ/
- Eph 5:32** This is a **great mystery**: but I speak concerning Christ and the church. /Christ/

7. Eph 6:19 And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the **mystery** of the gospel, /Prayer to speak the gospel, Ephesians 6:18-20/holy Spirit/
8. Col 1:27 To whom God would make known what [is] the riches of the glory of this **mystery** among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory: /God/holy Spirit = Christ in you/Colossians 1:26-29/
9. Col 2:2 That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgment of the **mystery** of God, and of the Father, and of Christ; /God-Father-Christ/John 13-17/Colossians 2:2-3/there is all saints/
10. Col 4:3 Withal praying also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance, to speak the **mystery** of Christ, for which I am also in bonds: /God/Prayer to speak the mystery of Christ/holy Spirit/
11. 1Ti 3:9 Holding the **mystery** of the faith in a pure conscience.
12. 1Ti 3:16 And without controversy great is the **mystery** of godliness: (1) God was manifest in the flesh, (2) justified in the Spirit, (3) seen of angels, (4) preached unto the Gentiles, (5) believed on in the world, (6) received up into glory. /Christ Jesus/(1) birth, (2) sinless, (3) temptations & Gethsemane, (4) by the 70 in Luke 10:1-30, (5) during the ministry of Jesus (6) at the ascension in Acts 1:3-11/Jesus/

1. By John: Re 1:20 The **mystery** of the seven stars which thou sawest in My right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches. /Jesus Christ/ Rev 2-3 to the 7 churches/Rev 22:16-21/

By Paul: “my” gospel prophetic mysteries, future rapture of the Church before the tribulation.

3 mysteries. Zero parables. Two “I Ams” in Revelation 1-3 by John.

1. Ro 11:25 For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this **mystery**, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in. /Ephesians 2:20-22/holy Spirit/Romans 16:25-27/after the rapture of the true church/
2. 1Co 15:51 Behold, I shew you a **mystery**; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, /rapazo/
3. 2Th 2:7 For the **mystery** of iniquity doth already work: only He who now letteth [will let], until He be taken out of the way. /rapture/holy Spirit/illumination in 1 John 2:12-14, Jude 3, 2 Peter 3:18.

By John: Prophetic mysteries, during the tribulation. 3 mysteries, which will be clear to the tribulation saints. 11 parables by Jesus. John presents Jesus as the returning king in 3 “I AMs” in Revelation 21-22.

1. Re 10:7 But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the **mystery** of God should be **finished**, as He hath declared to His servants the **prophets**. /God/OT prophets/10:1-6, the little book, no write-seal,/ end of trib/10:8-11 John ate little book/interlude 10:1-11:14, 6th-7th trumpet/
2. Re 17:5 And upon her forehead [was] a name written, **MYSTERY**, **BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH**. /17:6, drunk with blood of saints & Martyrs of Jesus/
3. Re 17:7 And the angel said unto me, Wherefore didst thou marvel? I will tell thee the **mystery** of the woman, and of the beast that carrieth her, which hath the seven heads and ten horns. /Rev 13:1-4, Da 7:10/Gen 10-11, Hammurabi Stele 1726-1686 BC/ Nebuchadnezzar/apostate religious system/

God – 11x, Christ – 6x, holy Spirit – 6x. (+) I, me, my – 4x (Paul). (+) we, us, our, saints, you, their – 12x.
 Revelation is complete, inspiration is finished, illumination is needed. Updated: 11 May 2026, W.Heath.
 No mystery in 16 books: John, Acts, 2 Corinthians, Galatians, Philippians, 1 Thessalonians, 2 Timothy, Philemon, Hebrews, 1 Peter, 2 Peter, James, 1 John, 2 John, 3 John, and Jude.
 Note 2: For convergence, see the **32 Parables Flowchart** and **John’s 12 ”I AMs” Timeline**. The **26 mysteries** may be compared to a U.S. roundabout, an entry point into the traffic flow of God’s plan for His glory and for His saints.
